





Don't Take Away God's Gift

What does it mean to be pro-life, and what is abortion in the first place? Well, whether to be pro-life or pro-choice is a big, difficult, and sensitive matter. Abortion is the killing of an innocent baby in a pregnant woman's womb, usually during the 12th and 13th weeks of pregnancy. Abortion is becoming one of the most prevalent methods for ending a pregnancy. We will cover how abortion works and some of the procedures, as well as some personal experiences and my personal beliefs on why abortion is such a terrible thing in this essay. This essay will also include my personal viewpoint on abortion, including why I believe it is wrong and why I choose to be pro-life.

So, after reading the introduction, you might be wondering yourself what is abortion and what are some abortion procedures? Well, there are a variety of abortion techniques available, but the two most prevalent are vacuum aspiration and dilation and evacuation. Vacuum aspiration is one of the two most popular abortion methods, and it involves a doctor numbing the lower half of the body or putting a tube through the cervix and into the uterus, killing the fetus by removing all tissue from the uterus. Dilation and evacuation are the other two most common abortion methods, with the latter being the crueller of the two. Dilation and evacuation is a process in which the patient's cervix is dilated, then narrow forceps are introduced into the womb's neck, the entire body is pulled out through the birth canal or by ripping off sections and finally, a suction machine is used to complete the evacuation. We can conclude that abortion techniques should be considered brutal by any normal person and soul after analyzing the two most popular abortion procedures.

After explaining how abortion works and its procedures you can see that abortion is not at all humane. Personally, from the baby's perspective, I could not imagine having painfully had pieces of my body being ripped off me one by one. I am every glad that my mom chose life. Another thing is the psychological part of abortion. I think that most parents would not give up their children for anything in the world. Most people wouldn't be able to forget the fact that they could've had a happy family and child, but decided to get rid of it like it was nothing. Another thing is that horrible things can happen to a woman's health such as them having a higher risk of developing breast cancer along with possibly having future reproductive problems. Abortion can develop and create physical and mental problems which further proves how it can be harmful to more than the soul and life which is being killed.

For example one of my family members was pregnant and one day they went for a check-up. The doctors were following up on the ultrasounds for the baby in the womb and said there is a good possibility that the baby might develop autism. The doctors recommended to the young lady that she have an abortion as it would be easier for them and my family members were very tempted in doing so. Luckily they didn't take the option to have an abortion and wished for the best as there was not a hundred percent certainty that the baby would be born unhealthy. Luckily she gave birth and it happens to be that the child didn't have autism. This just goes to show that you should never get an abortion whether the child might have any chance of disease.

In conclusion, I choose to be pro-life and influence others to also be pro-life because I believe in God and everything he wrote and believes in. Another big reason I choose to be pro-life is that abortion is the killing of a soul and someone's chance of being able to roam around the planet along with it breaking one of the ten commandments as the sixth commandment reads, you shall not kill. An additional reason is that I could not imagine anyone in my family at all being aborted from abortion because I deeply love all my family members whether it is my little sister, my mom, dad, cousin, or even my grandparents. So I think that we should all respect every life and soul whether it be born or still in the womb.

The Choice of Being Pro Life by Julia Zon

Imagine being at a young age, around nine or ten years old. Think about how many times you have said you're so excited to be a mother when you grow up. Then, the time comes where you end getting pregnant but want an abortion either because you are too young or just don't have the time, want to continue your career, or not be a single parent, or have limited income. Think about that moment in your life where you said you were so happy to one day have kids and now you have basically just lied to yourself and to God. Being pro-life means that a person votes and supports pro-life legislature, opposes pro-choice legislature, and leads with example.

This episode of a young baby life ending happens every single day to many women and it is just so sad to see them easily give up on their unborn child. What does pro-life actually mean though? Being pro-life basically means that you do not support the killing of an innocent baby and you choose to keep the child no matter what the circumstance. So many mothers today decide to have an abortion just because their partner is not a responsible individual or don't have "time" for a family. There are so many other options instead of getting an abortion like having a loving family adopt your child.

The choice of being pro-life does not just consist of not getting an abortion, but also not supporting abortion clinics, for example, Planned Parenthood. Planned Parenthood allows minors to get abortions without parental consent! A minor should not receive an abortion under no circumstance as fifteen-, sixteen- and seventeen-year-old girls are too young to fully comprehend the consequences of their enormous decision. Live Action uncovered circumstances where Planned Parenthood paid for Ubers for teenage girls to get from and to their procedure without their parents' consent. According to Live Action, most of these young girls are afraid to "disappoint their parents (Novielli)." Most of these girls of "overachievers" and worry that they will not attend med, law, undergraduate, graduate schools or start their own businesses (Novielli). However, as the articles states some parents might be at first shocked by the news that their daughter is pregnant, but will help them (Novielli). Most of these pregnant girls that do give birth eventually do go on to college, have successful careers, get married will with the help of their loving parents. Most importantly they do not regret having their child.

Unfortunately on January 17, 2022, New Jersey Gov. Murphy, codified abortion into New Jersey State's Constitution. This is very upsetting news for the state that I call home as it now allows abortions up until birth which is immoral and inhumane (Freiburger). This will have legal ramifications for doctors who refuse to have abortions based on their conscience and for religious hospitals (Freiburger). This means that my state does not value an innocent baby's life at all.

Also, the same New Jersey law mandates that the state must pay for an abortion no matter what circumstance and a minor does not need a guardian or parent's consent. Now think about that. The fact that part of our hard earned taxes goes to funding these clinics and abortions is just disgusting and hurtful to those who care enough for their children. Luckily, I don't pay taxes, but if I did, I would not want one penny of my hard money to go to fund abortions. My parents agree with me.

It is just dreadful to watch how many people go to Planned Parenthood clinics every single day because of a mistake they made. According to Archdiocese of Omaha Catholic Schools, "Mothers often don't choose life even when they know abortion is wrong because they feel like they can't handle the stress, pain and sacrifice of raising a child. Part of being a mother is making sacrifices for your children and those you love. In life we can't avoid suffering or pain," which demonstrates the selfish reason of why a mother may choose abortion even if it is the worst option, only worrying about herself and not about the child in her womb.

When my loving mother found out she was pregnant with my older sister and years later with me, she never even thought about getting an abortion. Even if her life might have been at risk because of me or my sister, she would always sacrifice our lives for herself. She loved me so much that she told my father not to save for her life is something would go wrong if I had a chance to survive. My mom nursed me for nine months in her womb by providing nourishment, safety, and most importantly love.
