

BAPTISM AT MT. CARMEL CHURCH

The National Shrine and Museum of St Therese Trip

Mt Carmel is hosting a trip to The National Shrine and Museum of St Therese in Darien, Illinois on Monday, September 16. The Shrine and museum feature the largest collection of St Therese's personal effects outside of Lisieux, France. The museum has several first class relics, a special prayer gazebo and a full sized exact replica of her convent cell which includes several second class relics. They also have a massive wood carving of her life which tells her whole story and is the largest wood carving of a religious nature in the United States. The museum features a large collection of Our Lady of Mount Carmel statues from around the world. All are welcome to join us on the trip! The registration fee is \$55 per person and covers the bus, bus driver gratuity, lunch, snacks and Shrine donation. This trip is limited to 40 people. 
