

European Union takes Hungary to court for banning

LGBT material in schools Brussels (LifeSiteNews, 7/10/22) -The European Commission, the executive branch of the European Union (EU), is taking Hungary to the EU's highest court over its pro-family law banning the promotion of homosexual and "transgender" materials to minors in schools. The European Commission decided to refer Hungary to the Court of Justice of the EU over the government's refusal to revoke its Children Protection Act, which outlaws the promotion of hypersexualized content, including pro-LGBT materials, in schools in an effort to clamp down on pedophilia. The bill prohibits showing pornographic material or content portraying homosexuality or transgenderism to minors under the age of 18. Other measures include a registry of sex offenders, regulations on sexual education, and stronger policies against child pornography. EU bureaucrats accused the nation's conservative Fidesz government, led by the popular Prime Minister Viktor Orbán, of discrimination against LGBT-identifying citizens with the new law and violating the principles upon which the EU allegedly stands.

PROFILE of CATHOLIC DIOCESE of KITUI, KENYA: 2nd special collection next weekend, August 6-7!

For many years our Mt. Carmel & St. Therese parishes have been assisting the Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya by hosting a priest who has preached on the needs of the people there. For the past two years, because of Covid, no priest came. But this year – next weekend, Sat/Sun Aug. 6-7 – Fr. Nicodemus Muithi will be at our church to speak about the Kitui Diocese, and we will have a 2nd special collection: Please make out checks to Mount Carmel Church with a note "Kitui Diocese."

Fr. Nicodemus is from the Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya. He has recently arrived from Kenya and resides at St. Mark's Parish in Peoria, IL. (Fr. Ben Reese was pastor at St. Mark's and it was he who first invited priests from the Kitui Diocese to help them raise money for the needs of the people there.) Fr. Nicodemus travels around the US doing mission appeals in the summer for the Kitui Diocese. He was ordained in 2005.

The Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya is a mission diocese that covers over 18,750 square miles. 26 parishes serve over one million people. The Kitui Diocese is in a sub Saharan plain, where one of the greatest challenges is drought and famine. Rainfall is unreliable. Poverty levels are at 70% with malnutrition at 52%. The main source of livelihood is subsistence farming: crop & livestock; but due to drought there is a frequent cycle of famine and most people are on food relief.

The trickledown effect of this influences everything including education, since schools close without clean water and fees for tuition are redirected to buy food since the crops fail. The burden that many feel during these times of need leave them feeling hopeless if not for their faith. Your support during this mission appeal is vital for the hope it provides.







In addition, the Kitui Diocese suffered from the Covid-19 pandemic, which caused severe economic hardship.

Bishop Joseph Mwongela of the Kitui Diocese has requested our assistance for many programs, including those that support orphans, family life ministry, and formation of seminarians/future priests.
