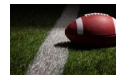

LOVE ONE ANOTHER Campaign Announcement – Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church

**The following was announced at last weekend's Masses, but since many were unable to attend b/c of the snow, I am placing it in this week's bulletin:*

- It's a great time to be a Catholic in southeastern Wisconsin!
- We have a strong and lively parish with faithful parishioners and wonderful volunteers.
- In the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, various Catholic ministries serve thousands each year across the 10 counties of southeastern Wisconsin such as:
 - Catholic Charities serving the poor and those in need.
 - Our mission in the Dominican Republic.
 - One of the larger Catholic school systems in the country.
 - Training of priests: The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has one of the highest per-capita seminarian counts in the nation – these are our future priests to keep our parishes open!
- As every family needs to plan and prepare for the future, so does our faith family here in southeastern Wisconsin. Together, we are taking responsibility for the mission and future of the Church.
- Following years of prayer and planning, we are embarking upon an important fundraising effort called the ***Love One Another Campaign*** – similar to *Faith in Our Future* that was initiated 16 years ago, back in 2007.
- In the current campaign, each of the 188 parishes in the Archdiocese will participate, and every family will be asked to make a pledge over 5 years to support local parish needs, and shared ministries.
- Our parish will receive 60% of all funds we raise, up to the parish goal, which is \$397,500; and our parish will receive a larger share if we go beyond the goal!
- We will use the funds raised to address important needs in our parish, the most important of which are:
 - installing a new HVAC (air conditioning) system for the church, hall and school, as our present air conditioning units are *beyond* their life span;
 - installing new roof membranes on the rectory and parts of our school, which will need to be done within the next few years.
 - The combined cost of these projects alone will be well over \$300,000 – more than the 60% that we hope to raise for our parish in this campaign.
 - Also, 10% of parish funds raised will be donated to the Diocese of Kitui, Kenya.
- I (Fr. Campbell) will need your help to conduct this campaign successfully.
- We will be sharing more information about the *Love One Another Campaign* in the weeks and months ahead.
- Please pray for the success of the *Love One Another Campaign*.
