Nobel Prize winner canceled by IMF after denouncing 'climate change' alarmism (LifeSiteNews, July 25, 2023) — Nobel Prize laureate Dr. John Clauser's talk at the International Monetary Fund (IMF) has been canceled following his outspoken criticism of the "climate change" agenda. PROFILE of CATHOLIC DIOCESE of KITUI, KENYA: 2nd special collection this weekend, August 5-6!

For many years our Mt. Carmel & St. Therese parishes have been assisting the Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya by hosting a priest who has preached on the needs of the people there. This year – this weekend, Sat/Sun August 5-6 – Fr. George Marete will be at our church to speak about the Kitui Diocese, and we will have a 2nd special collection: Please make out checks to Mt. Carmel Church with a note "Kitui Diocese."

Fr. George is from the Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya. He has recently arrived from Kenya and resides at St. Mark's Parish in Peoria, IL. (Fr. Ben Reese was pastor at St. Mark's and it was he who first invited priests from the Kitui Diocese to help them raise money for the needs of the people there.) Fr. George travels around the US doing mission appeals in the summer for the Kitui Diocese.

The Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya is a mission diocese that covers over 18,750 square miles. 26 parishes serve over one million people. The Kitui Diocese is in a sub Saharan plain, where one of the greatest challenges is drought and famine. Rainfall is unreliable. Poverty levels are at 70% with malnutrition at 52%. The main source of livelihood is subsistence farming: crop & livestock; but due to drought there is a frequent cycle of famine and most people are on food relief.

The trickledown effect of this influences everything including education, since schools close without clean water and fees for tuition are redirected to buy food since the crops fail. The burden that many feel during these times of need leave them feeling hopeless if not for their faith. Your support during this mission appeal is vital for the hope it provides.

Catholic priest calls on Arizona Gov. Katie Hobbs to 'immediately repent' of promoting

abortion PHOENIX, Arizona (LifeSiteNews, July 25, 2023) - Fr. Craig Friedley, the pastor of Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish in Queen Creek, Arizona, penned a letter to proabortion Arizona Gov. Katie Hobbs "for advancing a method to abort a child that disregards the safety of women beyond what she has done in the past." Fr. Friedley wrote in response to an announcement of a measure expanding access to over-the -counter contraceptives — many of which are abortifacients without a doctor's prescription. Friedley took the Democrat to task for her long-standing promotion of abortion up until birth under the guise of advocating for "women's health," saying her latest move "is not only immoral, but it means that you are placing your eternal soul in danger of damnation by your public, proud, and scandalous actions in supporting the murder of children in the womb." Friedley reminded Hobbs, who is Catholic, "You should immediately repent and go to confession for advocating for abortion in the public square. The murder of a child in the womb is not health care. Stop spreading this lie and causing a scandal in the Catholic Church. If you are still attending any Catholic Mass, you should refrain from presenting yourself for communion until you repent of spreading lies and advocating for the murder of children in the womb."
