## RFK Jr. says US rejects WHO declaration due to pro-abortion language, 'radical gender ideology'

Health and Human Services Secretary Robert F. Kennedy Jr. told the United Nations that the United States won't support World Health Organization (WHO) policies that promote abortion and radical gender ideology.

Speaking at a U.N. meeting on preventing and combating chronic illnesses, Kennedy said that the U.S. would reject a proposed U.N. declaration because it has overstepped its role. "We cannot accept language that pushes destructive gender ideology. Neither can we accept claims of a constitutional or international right to abortion."

"The WHO cannot claim credibility or leadership until it undergoes radical reform," said RFK Jr., who described the U.N. declaration as "political" in nature.

In a separate video message released on social media, Kennedy was even more pointed in his remarks: "A sound global policy must respect families, and cultures, and communities," explained Kennedy. "More specifically, we cannot accept language that pushes radical gender ideology. We believe in the biological reality of sex. Women deserve dignity, safety, and women-only spaces," he argued.

"We cannot accept claims of a constitutional or international right to abortion. As President Trump has said, 'global bureaucrats have absolutely no business attacking the sovereignty of nations that wish to protect innocent life,'" said Kennedy.

"We also can't cede authority to the World Health Organization," declared Kennedy.

# 2023 ABORTION NUMBERS

## Deciphering the latest figures and their limitations.

After months of pressure from state leaders, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) **finally released abortion statistics for 2023** in August 2025.

By law, DHS is required to report these numbers annually, yet under Governor Tony Evers' administration, reporting has been consistently and significantly delayed.

While the release is welcome, we must treat the numbers with caution.

They do not reflect the full picture of abortion in Wisconsin—and the reality is **likely far worse.**

Following the 2022 Supreme Court decision in *Dobbs v. Jackson, Roe v. Wade* was overturned, and Wisconsin's original pro-life law immediately went into effect. DHS's own report acknowledges this, stating: "Due to the overturn of *Roe v. Wade* in June 2022, abortion health care services were unavailable for 15 months (June 2022–September 2023) in the State of Wisconsin."

The reported decline in abortions compared to 2021 and 2022 is worth celebrating. However, the data obscures a troubling trend: according to the Guttmacher Institute, 63% of reported abortions nationally are now chemical abortions.

Abortion pills can now be obtained through the mail with no doctor visit, no age verification, and no oversight. This means the true number of lives lost is likely much higher than what DHS records capture.




The picture also extends beyond state lines. In neighboring Illinois—where abortion laws are among the least protective in the nation—**abortions rose by more than 15,000 in just one year.** It is reasonable to conclude that many Wisconsin women traveled across the border for abortions.


