

### BAPTISM AT MT. CARMEL CHURCH

Parents must be contributing members, regularly attending weekly Mass, for at least 4 months. In preparation for the sacrament, a one hour class for parents must be completed prior to the baptism, please contact the rectory, 652-7660, at least 2 months in advance.

### MARRIAGE ARRANGEMENTS

Should be made with the pastor at least six months to one year before the proposed wedding date. One member of the couple must be a registered, practicing member and contributor of record at Mt. Carmel for at least six months. Couples sharing the same abode will be asked to live separately prior to their marriage .

\**Ash Wednesday* is a day of both *abstinence & fasting*: Everyone 14 years old and up must abstain from meat; 18 to 65 years old must also fast: have only one full meal, may eat 2 other meals that together do not equal the main meal, and no eating between meals.\**Abstinence* from meat is required on *ALL FRIDAYS* during Lent; and *GOOD FRIDAY* is also a day of both *abstinence and fasting*.

Fr. Edward Looney is a priest for the Diocese of Green Bay, Wisconsin, and currently serves as Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish, Shawano. A member and past President of the Mariological Society of America, Fr. Looney has authored many books and has published in theological journals on topics related to Mariology.

Fr. Looney has expertise regarding the apparitions by Our Lady of Champion (formerly called Our Lady of Good Help) to Adele Brice. Texts on this topic: *Our Lady of Good Help: Mary's Name, Message and Mission* and *The Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help: Frequently Asked Questions*. He has authored a number of devotional works: *Praying the Rosary with Sister Adele*, *A Novena to the Queen of Heaven Our Lady of Good Help*, *A Rosary Litany*, and *A Heart Like Mary's: 31 Daily Meditations to Help You Live and Love as She Does*; and two children's books: *The Story of Sister Adele*, and *Breakfast in Bethlehem*.
