The 2015-16 school year was one of faith-filled enrichment, achievements, and farewells. At the end of June, we said goodbye to Jim Lee, our principal for the last five years, as well as to some long-time employees. As we reflect on our past accomplishments and look with excitement and hope to our future, we present to you the 2015-16 Annual Report.

For only the second time in the history of the school, our parent community, together with the faculty and staff, had a 100% Annual Fund participation. This outpouring of support speaks volumes about the generosity of our school family and their belief in IHM. And most importantly, it is a strong indicator to others outside our community that IHM is a worthy investment!

The iLearn program was expanded to include grades 1-8, providing students with individualized differentiated instruction. During the 2015-16 school year, the students utilized this program twice a week to reinforce the Archdiocesan standards. This also allowed students to remediate when needed as well as give them enrichment opportunities.

While our academic instruction excels, it is our faith-based instruction that continues to distinguish an Immaculate Heart of Mary School education. In the Catholic tradition, our students grow in faith, understanding, and wisdom each day. Faculty, staff, students, and parents strive to model the Christ-like virtues in all aspects of their lives.

Students across all grade levels participated in various faith-based experiences which ultimately strengthened their knowledge of our Catholic beliefs. One historic moment was the ceremony and releasing of doves as Pope Francis flew over Georgia. The toy drive in December was noted as the largest donation of its kind with Catholic Charities. The number of volunteers hours given by our students as they reach out to the parish, community, and others in need is remarkable.

The 2016-17 school year promises to be a year of strategic planning while placing an emphasis on educating the whole child. We will look toward differentiated instructional strategies to ensure the needs of all our students are being met. With our 60th Anniversary quickly approaching in 2018, we will show how IHM has thrived and grown to become the highly effective school it is today. We need your continual support to plan for the future successes of IHM for many years to come.

We look forward to the partnership as we continue this journey together.

2015-2016 Highlights

- Students welcomed Pope Francis to America by releasing doves during an all-school prayer service.
- The iLearn math program which provides individualized instruction to students was expanded to include all 1-8 students.
- A total of \$395,893 was awarded in scholarships and tuition assistance.
- The Annual Fund reached 100% parent participation, an accomplishment only achieved once before in the history of the school.
- IHM hosted International Night for a third year in a row. The school community boasts over a dozen languages spoken in students' homes.
- The Annual Fund topped \$200,000, the second highest campaign on record.
- IHM was awarded the title of "No Place for Hate" by the Anti-Defamation League for the fifth year in a row.
- The Middle School Dinner Theatre production of The Lion King Jr. performed to sold-out crowds.

- Phase One of the playground was installed and dedicated to the memory of former IHM employee and 2006 graduate Christine McLellan.
- 25 students were scholarship award recipients through the GRACE Scholars program.
- Four grants as well as several restricted gifts funded the purchase of science leveled readers and science equipment and supplies for students in grades 1-8.



- Captain Planet Foundation awarded IHM School a three-year partnership grant to continue expanding our garden program.

- Mrs. Ruthie Patch retired after 27 years of service.
- Annalise O'Connell '19 and Zach Sutter '20 were declared the Zaner Bloser State Handwriting Champions for Georgia.
- An IHM team won the Archdiocesan third grade Battle of the Books competition.
- Jamie Martin '16 received the Daughters of the American Revolution Award.



- Director of Curriculum Anna Jimenez was named employee of the year.
- Claire Trainor '16 was selected by her peers to receive the Renee Richardson Award which honors a student who models Gospel values and exemplifies a positive attitude at IHM.
- Christian Forbes '16 and Leah Kesler '16 were each awarded the Katie Granger Memorial Literature Award.
- Sylvie Buckalew '16 received the IHM Laureate Award.

- Maria Murphy '17 received the Blessed Trinity Catholic High School Book Award.
- Marcelus Burwell '16 was awarded the Chi Rho Award from St. Pius X Catholic High School.



- The Home & School Association's bi-annual auction, "Light Up the Night in Central Park," raised over \$135,000, including nearly \$50,000 for phase two of the playground expansion.

IHM Finance Council

The Parish Finance Council is an advisory body whose membership includes individuals with an expertise in management, business, civil law and/or finance. The Parish Finance Council does not have decision making authority, but actively reviews budgets and monthly financial reports and shares information, generates discussion and promotes consensus. They provide guidance and counseling to the pastor and principal, promoting the financial health of the parish and school.



Home & School Association

The Home & School Association is a vital and active organization made up of volunteer parents. The Home & School Association works in partnership with faculty and staff to meet the needs of the school community and offers meaningful ways to strengthen the bonds of our community. Members work to enhance communication between parents and the school as well as sponsor programs, coordinate volunteers, support teachers and staff, and provide

supplemental income to strengthen the financial health of the school. The 2015-2016 school year was very successful thanks to the efforts of our amazing parent volunteers and the support of IHM families, friends and parishioners. The Home & School Association raised nearly \$116,000. The surplus of more than \$94,000 was returned to the school to use toward operating and capital expenses and nearly \$50,000 was raised for the Fund-A-Cause which went toward the expansion of the back field playground and basketball court. Highlights from 2015-2016 included the Light Up the Night in Central Park Gala, Staff Appreciation Week, hospitality for events such as Grandparents' Day, Veterans Day, and Parent Coffees, and fun for the whole family at Pizza/DJ Night.

Endowment funds provide an ever-increasing source of income, securing IHM School's long-term stability. A gift to the endowment fund is set aside permanently, as only the earnings and income are used, leaving the balance intact to continue to grow. IHM School has two endowed scholarship funds, Edward Barnsley '86 Memorial Endowed Scholarship and Goizueta Foundation Endowed Scholarship. The School also has three endowment funds that are not yet endowed, including the IHM School Endowment Fund, the Memorial Scholarship Fund and the Vivian Adán Eager Reader Scholarship Fund.

IHM School Endowment

This endowment fund is unique, in that IHM School set an internal goal of raising \$1M before any funds can be used. IHM School received a \$1M gift from an anonymous donor in 2009 that will roll into the Endowment Fund in 2019. Once fully endowed, the Fund will support the general mission of IHM School in addition to supporting needs-based scholarships, teacher professional development, continuing education and advanced degree scholarships and as specified by the donor in cases of qualified donations. The GRACE Scholars program provides need-based scholarships to families who otherwise could not afford a Catholic school tuition. Funded by Georgia taxpayers who redirect part of their Georgia State income tax to GRACE, these donors receive a 100% state income tax credit

for their gift while helping to make a Catholic school education a reality for families in need. In another highly competitive year, the \$58.5M in funds allocated for the taxpayer-funded student scholarship program were depleted on the first business day of 2016. IHM School received gift designations totaling \$225,000, a record high. Because of this increase in donor designations and despite the proration of nearly 50%, IHM was able to secure \$119,771 for student scholarships. A total of 25 students receive GRACE Scholarships at IHM thanks to this generosity!
