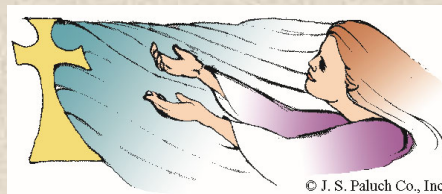

**Saint Teresa of Jesus (1515-1582)
October 15**

Let nothing disturb you; let nothing frighten you. Gifted with a passionate spirit, young Teresa dreamed of converting Muslims and becoming a martyr. All things are passing; God never changes. But her mother's death when Teresa was fourteen inspired lifelong devotion to Our Lady, and Teresa entered the Carmelites, Mary's order, despite her father's objections and her own fragile health. Patience gains everything. Initially, she enjoyed her lax convent's sociability and "busyness," but mystical prayer and John of the Cross's collaboration inspired her to reform the Carmelites. Whoever has God, lacks nothing. When her ideals encountered resistance and brought suffering, she maintained her peace—and humor. Discovered devouring leftovers, she told her mildly scandalized nuns, "When I fast, I fast! When I eat, I eat!" To nuns demanding less work and more prayer in the convent schedule, she retorted: "What we really need around here are fewer starry eyes and more strong arms!" God alone is enough! The italicized sentences here are her "Breviary Bookmark," the simple, profound prayer of Teresa, the first woman Doctor of the Church.

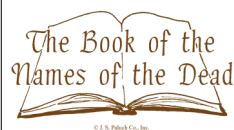
**Prayers for the Sick and Dying**

Down through the ages, Christian communities have honored and remembered their dead. We see their names on the walls and windows of churches and on grave markers in cemeteries. We read their names in prayers of intercession and recall their anniversaries.

Especially during the month of November - with its solemnity of All Saints and commemoration of All Souls - Catholics both remember the dead and prepare for their own death.

Again this year we have another opportunity to remember those who have died. Our **"Book of the Names of the Dead"** will be displayed in the back of Church near the Baptismal font. A candle is lit and placed nearby, symbolizing that the deceased have shared in the waters of Baptism; dying with Christ and rising to new life. The placement of the book in this place gives us hope that our beloved dead now share in Christ's Resurrection.

Parishioners are invited to enter the names of loved ones who have died **since this time last year**. The book will be left out from the solemnity of All Saints until the start of Advent. All those who have been remembered will be prayed for during those intercessions at our liturgies in November.

GOD REVEALED TO THE NATIONS

What wonderful images we have today of the reign of God! Isaiah speaks to us of a great feast—a heavenly feast—a feast of abundance with rich foods and choice wines. It is the Lord's own affair, Isaiah explains, when God will unite all nations, dry every tear, and destroy death forever. Then, too, will the entire earth rejoice in the Lord and bask in God's saving grace.

Jesus speaks of heaven in terms of a feast as well. Here, the kingdom of heaven is likened to a king's wedding feast given for his son. This is a feast of abundance also, with the fattened cattle prepared just so. But many of the people invited don't want to come, so the king invites anyone who would honor his son by their presence there. And Paul tells us that whether we live abundantly or in humble circumstances, we can do all things in the Lord who strengthens us. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

Dear Friends,

On behalf of the volunteers of our St. Francis food pantry ministry, we would like to thank all the parishioners for their overwhelming generosity and support which allowed us to keep the food pantry open throughout these months of the pandemic. Between March 2020 and July 2020, with your help, we have served 406 families feeding over 1,373 people.

Looking forward, it is hard to believe that summer is coming to an end and that Thanksgiving will soon be upon us. Along with everything else happening in our lives, this year we are faced with a new set of challenges relative to our annual Thanksgiving basket distribution.

The main hub from which we have received much of the holiday food is not offering holiday food this year. Therefore, there is a much greater need for us to provide the food for the 100 local families we support through our Thanksgiving Basket drive. We are hoping with your assistance we can provide food for our neighbors in need.

This year instead of individual items we are asking that you commit to providing a complete family thanksgiving bag.

A family bag includes:

- 2 boxes of stuffing
- 1 large box potato flakes
- 1 can cranberry sauce
- 2 cans each: corn, carrots, and green beans
- 1 box Lipton soup
- 1 jar tomato sauce and 1 box pasta.



The food pantry will supplement each family bag with other items, such as bread, desserts, tableware...etc

We also need 100 turkeys to give out with the baskets.

The deadline to drop off a Family Thanksgiving food bag and/or a turkey is November 8th
