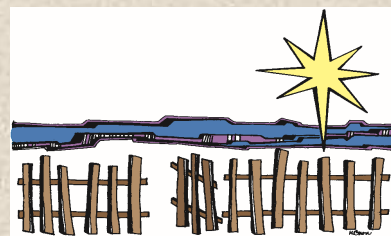

During the Advent season, households should spend time together preparing for the approaching celebration of the birth of Christ. The Advent wreath has become one of the most meaningful customs of the season. Its simplicity and meaning have a special appeal for children. Observing the Advent season in this special way can bring a family together in thought and prayer and fill all who participate with a warm sense of belonging and spiritual presence.

Like so many of our Christian customs, the Advent wreath is an adaptation of an ancient practice that dates back to pre-Christian times. Long ago in northern Europe, the growing dark and winter weather in Advent forced people to remove the wheels from their carts and replace them with snow runners. The wheels were hung high in the rafters of the house, fitted out with lanterns, and wound tightly with evergreen boughs. Candles were lighted around a wheel during the festival of the winter solstice to celebrate the return of gradually lengthening daylight. Although the history of the Advent wreath is noteworthy, the meaning and symbolism of it carry a greater significance for us as we anticipate the birth of Christ and the enlightenment His coming brings to our lives.

The season of Advent is a time of hopeful anticipation for the birth of Christ. With its rounded garland and four candles, the Advent wreath is a decorative extension of that hope. The garland, which is often made from the trimmings of the Christmas tree, is shaped into a circle to symbolize the eternal God and our ongoing life. It also commemorates new life and a fresh start to the upcoming year.

The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent. Three candles are blue and the fourth is pink, the color of the vestments traditionally worn on the third Sunday of Advent.

The wreath is placed on a table or suspended from the ceiling. One candle is lit for each Sunday of Advent, until all four are radiating light, designed to welcome the birth of Jesus, the light of the world. A fifth candle, white in color, is placed in the center of the wreath and lit on Christmas morning.

Blessing of the Advent Wreath

The blessing of the Advent wreath is meant to accompany the start of the Advent Season. Following is a suggested blessing and service for each of the 4 weeks of Advent. There are many variations of the Advent wreath ceremony and many different published prayers and devotions. You may prefer to use your family's own words, prayers and customs.

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

All: Who has made heaven and earth.

Leader: Let us pray, O God, by whose Word all things are made holy, pour forth your blessings upon this wreath, and grant that we who use it may prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ. Amen.

FIRST WEEK

Leader: The Lord is our faith and our life.

All: May the Lord's peace be with us all.

Leader: And His love shine in our hearts.

All: Our hope is in the coming of the Lord.

One blue candle is lit (traditionally by the youngest child; however, you may want all of your children to share in this activity). During the rest of the week, this candle is re-lit at the evening meal or whenever the family gathers together.

Leader: Let us pray, that our faith may be strengthened for the coming of the Lord. (Pause for silent prayer.) Father in heaven, our hearts desire the warmth of your love and our minds are searching for the light of your Word. Increase our longing for Christ our Savior and give us strength to grow in our faith so that the day of His coming may find us prepared and filled with joy.
