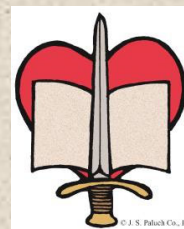

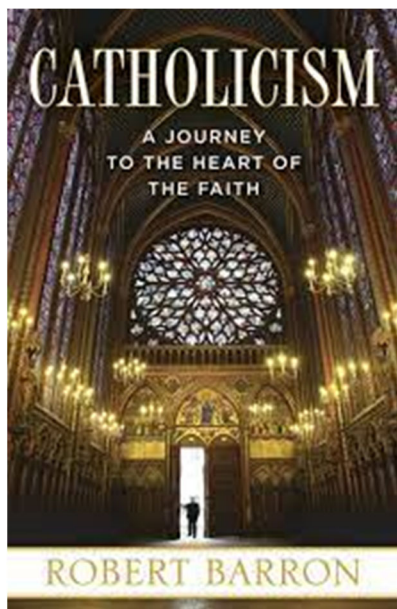

You must be registered in the parish for at least six months prior to setting a date. The couple is expected to worship with the community and commit themselves to the Marriage Preparation program.
