

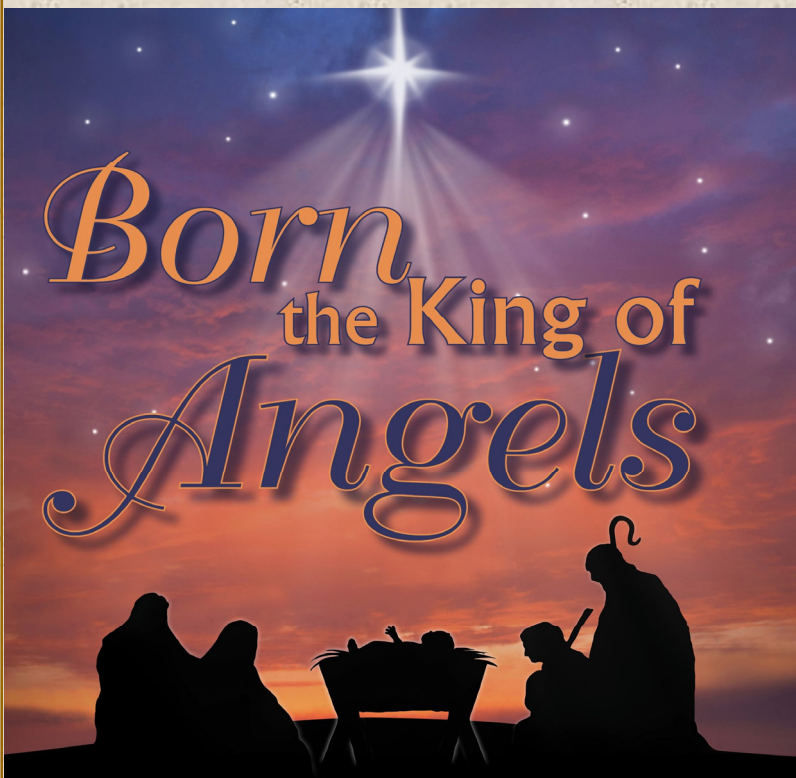

We have come again to the joy of Christmas! The Word of God that took on flesh is now Emmanuel, God with us! Each year, the celebration of Christmas is an opportunity to remind ourselves of God's great love for us and Christ's closeness to us. 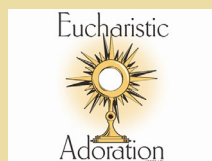

Sacrament of the Sick: Those who are sick, homebound, or in the hospital are a vital part of our parish family. Please call the parish office to arrange for the reception of the Eucharist and Anointing of the Sick.

Sacrament of Baptism: Parents must be registered members of the parish and attend a preparation class before arranging for the baptism of their child. Please call the parish office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Couples planning to marry at St. Francis de Sales should contact the pastor at least one year in advance and before making any other arrangements. You must be registered in the parish for at least six months prior to setting a date. The couple is expected to worship with the community and commit themselves to the Marriage Preparation program.
