



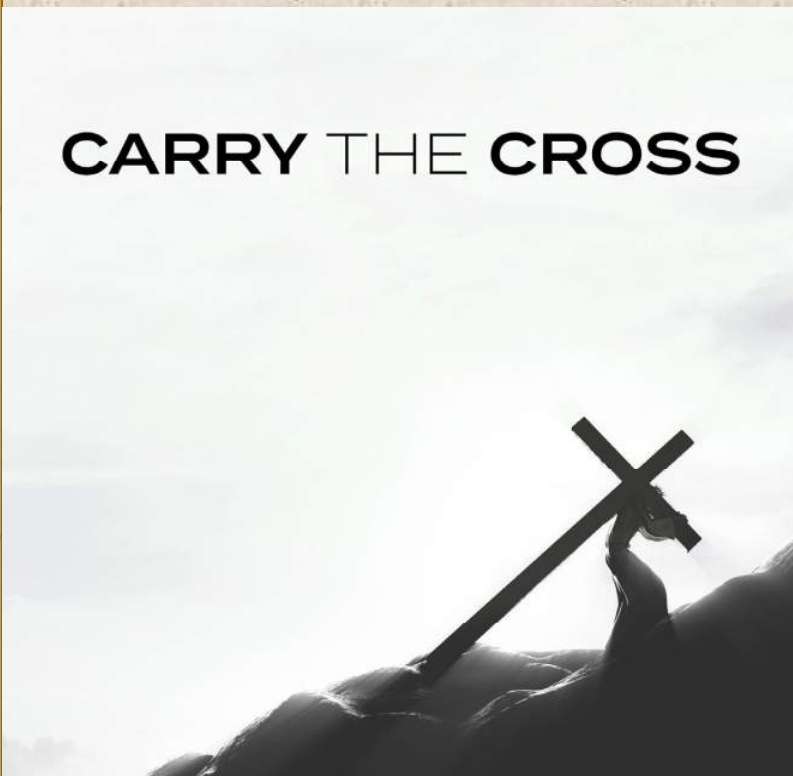

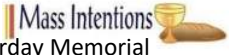

Our Church - Our Faith

ST PETER CLAVER

Saint Peter Claver (1580-1654) was born in Spain and ministered in the area now known as Columbia. He has long held a place on the liturgical calendar of the United States. When the third edition of The Roman Missal was published in Latin in 2002, his observance was extended to every country on earth. The memorial of Peter Claver on September 9 is optional in most countries, but obligatory in the United States.

Peter attended the University of Barcelona and joined the Jesuits, who sent him on mission to South America. He never returned to Spain. He was ordained a priest at the cathedral in Cartagena, and spent most of his ministry among the slaves arriving on ships from Africa. He did other work for the sick and the unfortunate, but his care for the physical and spiritual wellbeing of the slaves is remembered most. Through forty years of service, he is said to have baptized 300,000 slaves. Pope Leo XIII canonized Peter Claver in 1888, the same year he wrote an encyclical to the bishops of Brazil prohibiting slavery.

Peter considered himself "a slave of the slaves," and the Collect for September 9 explicitly recalls this. The same Collect prays that "we may love our neighbor in deeds and in truth," and Christians today would do well to emulate Peter Claver's selfless example.

Many do. The Josephite fathers in Mobile, Alabama, founded an organization for Black Catholic men in 1909 called the Knights of St. Peter Claver. The group appealed to those who admired the fraternal and benevolent works of similar entities, but who were searching for one rooted within Catholic traditions. A Ladies Auxiliary was authorized in 1922 in Opelousas, Louisiana. Both organizations continue today, inspired by the ministry and under the patronage of St. Peter Claver.

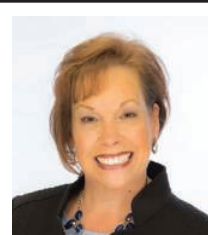
