


Mission Statement

SCRUTINIES

If you are a cradle Catholic sitting in the pew during the third, fourth, and fifth Sunday of Lent, and OCIA members join you at mass, you are present for "the Scrutinies", whether you realize it or not. What are they, and why are they important for all of us during this Lenten season of repentance and renewal?

The Scrutinies are three special rites that help prepare the Elect, those participating in the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), to enter the Catholic Church. They take place during the period of OCIA formation known as Purification and Enlightenment, near the end of their formation.


The season of Lent involves a more intense period of examination and preparation for the Elect, and hopefully for those of us already living the Catholic faith. Though they are meant for the OCIA elect, the Scrutinies can help all Catholics seeking to live a life of continuous conversion.

The purpose of the Scrutinies is to "uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful" in the hearts of the Elect and to strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good."

During the three-week period of the Scrutinies, the Elect open the eyes of their souls, examine carefully how sin works in their lives, and make the deliberate choice to turn away from sin so they can step joyfully into the light of Christ at their Baptisms.
