Join us at Stricker's Grove for the annual Parish Picnic. Bring your family and friends and enjoy a day of food, fun, games, and rides.


Gates open at NOON. Rides open from 1-4 and 5-8 PM. Games and activities will be arranged to keep the kids busy between ride times.
