



There are a number of important duties at Guardian Angels that relate to our celebration of the Eucharist. EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS help the priest with administering the sacraments of holy communion, the consecrated bread and wine. They may also take the sacraments to

those who are ill, or otherwise unable to attend mass. Sacristans assist clergy with the set up for Mass including liturgical books, the vestments, and other things necessary in the celebration of Mass. They can also prepare the altar for mass, including making sure all sacred vessels are positioned correctly. Greeters and Ushers are exactly what their titles imply. Greeters are positioned to make sure that people are welcomed as they enter church. Ushers collect the Offertory gifts and can assist parishioners with finding seats.

Baptism

Saturday afternoon between 3:00 and 3:45 pm and by appointment at the parish office.

Religious Education

Sessions for children and families are held monthly. Contact the parish office for more information.
