

#### PASTOR'S CORNER

Beloved.

Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

This beautiful prayer of humility is recited just before receiving Holy Communion. It comes from a Gospel story recorded by both Matthew and Luke where a Roman soldier, who is a Centurion by rank and a Gentile, comes to Jesus not seeking healing for himself, but for one of his slaves. It is a very tender Gospel moment. Gentiles were hated by Jews. Romans, in particular, were hated by Jews. And Roman soldiers, hated most of all. I'm sure many thought Jesus should just send him away.

Instead, Jesus has compassion on the outsider who has come seeking a miracle for his slave. The story would certainly look different if he had requested a miracle for himself. Most of us want a miracle from time to time. A miracle of healing. A miracle in finances. A miracle in a relationship. Most of us face some kind of want or need that we cannot take care of ourselves. But the Centurion had compassion on a slave, and so Jesus had compassion on him.

Jesus tells the Centurion that he would come with him, but the Centurion, knowing the stigma of a Jewish Rabbi coming to the home of a Roman soldier holds him off, "You don't need to come," the Centurion tells him. "I am a soldier. I understand authority. Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my servant shall be healed." Jesus commended the Centurion for his faith.

What about us? Do we come to receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ in faith? Do we believe in Christ's word, spoken by the priest? "Take, eat, this is my Body...Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood."

The last act of faith before taking the flesh and blood of Christ into our flesh and blood is to pray, "Only say the word and my soul shall be healed."

#### Sexual Abuse




- 1. Call the Missouri Child Abuse Hotline at 1.800.392.3738 (if the victim is currently under the age of 18), and
- 2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or call 911,
- 3. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816.812.2500 or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org, if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
