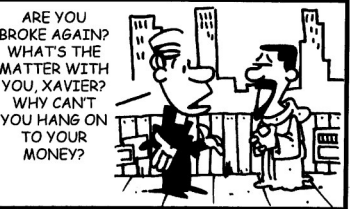
VOLUNTEER SIGN UP

PASTORS CORNER

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Luke 16:1-13
September 18, 2022

Today's Gospel is called the Parable of Dishonest Steward. The key to understanding this parable is when Jesus says, "the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light." Jesus praises the steward because he was prudent; he knew what to do next in time of crisis. "The master recommended the dishonest steward for acting prudently." Indeed, Jesus was impressed with the steward's resourcefulness.

Prudence also means astuteness, cleverness, shrewdness. Prudence means having the knowledge of what a person needs to do (a foresight) in facing a crisis and the concrete means to accomplish it. The rich man in the parable was most probably an absentee landowner. He was so rich that he had to hire someone (steward) to manage his finances. The steward was accused of being dishonest and the master believed it. Learning that he would soon be fired, the steward wasted no time in planning to secure for his future. He was clever to figure out what to do next.

Jesus praises the steward's cleverness to tell us that we need to be just as clever as the steward in planning to secure our future for ourselves not just in this life but more importantly for our time in eternity. Jesus is constantly reminding us that material things can make us feel secure, so secure in this life that we forget about what is more important, our eternal security in God's Kingdom. As children of light, Jesus seems to tell us that we give as much time and energy to what matters to secure our eternal future with God as do the children of darkness to what does not matter.
