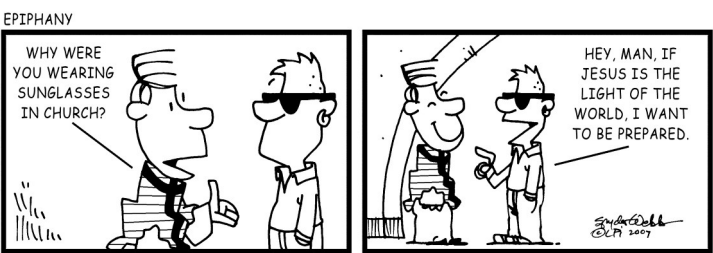

PASTORS CORNER

The Epiphany of the Lord
Matthew 2:1-12
January 8, 2023

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. It means the Lord has manifested Himself to the Gentiles represented by the Magi or the Wise Men from the East through the guidance of a Star. When we reflect on the story of the Magi in Matthew 2:1-12, we must remember that the Star was up there to see. The Magi were prompted to journey westward by the appearance of a bright star they had never seen before. They looked upwards in amazement at the wonder of the filled sky.

Scripture, scholars and historians cannot determine with precision which star shone with such particular brilliance at Jesus' birth. However, the important lesson in the story is that those Magi from the East (Mt. 2:1) had seen the Star, read its meaning and followed it. "We have seen His star and have come to worship Him" (Mt. 2:2).

The Star of Bethlehem was there for us to see, but did we miss it because our eyes were narrowly focused on many other things? For lack of vision, did we fail to grasp the meaning of Christmas for our lives? For lack of vision, did we fail to experience the presence of the Emmanuel in our Christmas celebration? With their vision and wisdom, the Magi were able to see beyond a little child; they were able to see the sign (a bright star) God had given them that this Child was destined to do great things.

As we gather in prayer at Mass, Jesus is making Himself known to us as the Bread of Life, and that He is the Emmanuel who is God-with-us and for us. Like the Magi we give Him homage.
