

PASTORS CORNER

First Sunday of Lent Matthew 4:1-11 February 26, 2023

The Gospel for the first Sunday of Lent is one of the most encouraging Gospels in the whole liturgical year. It tells us of the temptation of Jesus by the devil. The Gospel today opens with the words, "Jesus was led into the desert by the Spirit to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterward He was hungry..."

God wanted Jesus to go to the desert to fight with the devil. In the Old Testament times Israel was tempted by the devil in the desert and repeatedly succumbed to the devil's temptation. In fact, Moses himself was punished by God and not allowed to enter the Promised Land because He failed to show full faith in God in the desert of Sin. Now Jesus will save God's people; the embodiment and leader of renewed Israel, will confront the devil and this time He will win.

What was the nature of Jesus' temptations in the desert? Scripture scholars tell us that the point of Satan's temptations is not to directly get Jesus to abandon His mission of which God gave Him heightened awareness after His baptism by John the Baptist. The devil's intention is just to get Jesus to abandon the way God has set out for our salvation, the way of the Suffering Servant. The devil's pitch was, "OK, be the Messiah, but do things my way, not God's Way." The devil knows that a person who abandons God's way will also abandon God in the long run. That is why in our life we should not just look for success in our work for God's Kingdom. We should pray and work for the success that God wants in the way God wants. The way that God wants is not always the easiest way, but the way marked by the Cross.

The Gospel shows us that because Jesus experienced temptation, He knows how hard it is to resist; He understands us when we give in. Yet, Jesus wants us to know that He will help us when we are tempted. We pray that our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving will give us greater strength to resist temptation to sin.
