## Building Fund Update!

Summer is here and it has started off with a bang. Many things have been happening around Guardian Angels.

**Do you ever wonder what Guardian Angels does with the BUILDING FUND money?**

We thought we would list the projects that have recently been accomplished.

As you can imagine, running a 116 year-old church takes a lot of money to maintain. With your generous donations to help our church, we can do our best to keep things up to date. We will always have maintenance and small jobs that we feel we (parishioners) can do to help cut down on expenses. Although there are some jobs we must hire professionals.

Here is the list that has been accomplished:

- Replace parish office toilet and flooring
- Our Lady of Hope school kitchen was totally professionally cleaned
- Pilot lights on cafeteria stove were connected and turned on
- All water faucets in church bathrooms (upstairs and downstairs) were replaced with automatic shut ons and offs
- Parish Hall toilets (3) had auto flushes installed
- Parish Hallways and church bathrooms have new flooring
- All 3 Parish Hall bathrooms have new paint (THANK YOU George, Janis, Ed and Nikita)
- Our Church air conditioner has 2 new compressors
- Parish Hall has 2 air conditioner units. One was fixed and repaired. The other was totally replaced
- All 3 church chandeliers were lowered and all 36 bulbs were replaced. (THANK YOU Holy Name Society for the cost of the new light bulbs). Once the lights were lowered they were all hand cleaned. This was a very meticulous job. Some of you may remember Lucy Urlacher and Chris Vitt from our previous staff here at GA. A call to Lucy asking for help and assistance was graciously answered. Both girls came one Saturday morning along with their niece Claire and nephew Daniel and 2 parishioners David Arciga and Debra Barbosa. It was about a 5-hour job. It had been about 20 years since those lights had been lowered, bulbs changed and cleaned.
- All 3 north drains in the parking lot were repaired
- Parish Hall kitchen drain was unclogged
- Parish Office steps facing Westport Road were fixed and new concrete was laid by the side door entrance into the office. This has also helped with the monthly deliveries from
