Brother Knights,





Nicholas, familiarly known as "Little John," was small in stature but big in the esteem of his fellow Jesuits.

Born at Oxford, this artisan saved the



His work, which he did completely by himself as both architect and builder, was so good that priests in hiding were undetected by raiding parties. Nicholas was a genius at finding and creating places of safety.

At one point he was even able to mastermind the escape of two Jesuits from the Tower of London. After many years at his unusual task, Nicholas entered the Society of Jesus and served as a lay brother, although—for very good reasons—his connection with the Jesuits was kept secret.

After a number of narrow escapes, he himself was finally



caught in 1594. Despite protracted torture, Nicholas refused to disclose the names of other Catholics. After being released following the payment of a ransom, "Little John" went back to his work. He was arrested again in 1606. This time he was subjected to horrible tortures, suffering an agonizing death. Nicholas Owen was canonized in 1970 as one of the 40 Martyrs of England and Wales.






