



FROM THE DESK OF FR. DOOLEY

Hello Friends!

By now, you've probably received the postcard regarding the new Mass times. But in case you haven't, I wanted to use my column this week to reiterate the reason for the upcoming change.

As you are aware, this spring our diocese began a strategic planning initiative called *Real Presence Real Future*. The plan was designed to evaluate diocesan offices, parish ministries, and demographic trends, and thus enable us to make decisions based on the information collected. Some of the results have been encouraging, and we plan to build on this information as we move forward here at Our Lady of Peace.

But the RPRF initiative has also forced us to face some hard facts - for example, the declining number of priests. Last year, in response to this reality, Bishop Robert Brennan asked all parishes to evaluate Mass schedules. Here at OLP we decreased our weekend Masses from 4 to 3. Then during COVID, to allow plenty of time to clean and disinfect between Masses, we reorganized our Mass times. Now that we have the freedom to readjust our schedules, we have made the decision to change the Sunday Mass times to **8:45am and 11:30am**. The time in-between the Masses will allow PSR, other ministries and social events to take place during that time. (The 4:30pm Saturday Mass will remain. Daily Mass times will also not change, except for Fridays, which will be our All School Mass and will begin at 8:15.)

Our new Mass times will go into effect the weekend of **September 11th and 12th**. I know change can be difficult, but I am confident that our new Mass schedule is healthy and practical for the Lord's Day!

Let us pray for one another as we continue to celebrate 75 years proclaiming the Gospel message.


