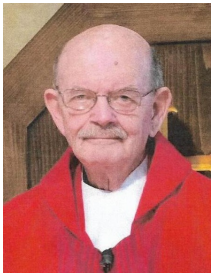

OBITUARY FOR MONSIGNOR EDWARD J. FAIRCHILD

Former OLP Pastor,
Reverend Monsignor
Edward J. Fairchild
passed away at the age

of 88 on Friday, December 24, 2021.

Msgr. Fairchild was born on March 22, 1933 in Columbus, the oldest son of the late Joseph W. and Marie (Lawler) Fairchild. He is survived by three brothers, William (Jean) Fairchild, Joseph W. (Elaine) Fairchild Jr, and James (Linda) Fairchild, all of the Columbus area; nephews Thomas Fairchild, Stephen (Janice) Fairchild, Michael (Mary) Fairchild, and nieces Monica (Ivan) Samuelson, Lisa (Lou) Hamilton, Jennifer (Bill) Beck, Brenda (Michael) Cornett and Susan (Erich) Stehle, and many great-nephews and great-nieces, and beloved pug, Paulie.

Msgr. attended Holy Rosary Grade School and High School Class of 1951, St. Charles College and Mount St. Mary of the West in Norwood, Ohio. He was ordained in St. Joseph Cathedral on May 30, 1959 by Bishop Isenmann. He taught at Chillicothe Central Catholic High School and Bishop Hartley High School in Columbus. He was assistant pastor at Chillicothe St. Mary and Columbus Christ the King.

He was co-pastor at Columbus Our Lady of Peace before founding St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in Pickerington. He then went on to become pastor of Columbus St. Peter and Westerville St. Paul before retiring in July of 2003. Monsignor Fairchild was on the Priest Senate, the Diocesan Finance Review Board, and was chairman of the Bishop's Committee for Priest's Salaries. He was named a prelate of honor on September 24, 1992.

The family sincerely thanks those who provided care for Msgr. Fairchild, including the Carmelite Sisters of the Aged and Infirm and staff at Mother Angeline McCrory Manor and the Villas at St. Therese and the physicians, nurses and staff at Mount Carmel East Hospital.

A NOTE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear Our Lady of Peace Family,

If I live to be as old as Betty White...

I have been thinking about that this week since I learned that the television star died on New Year's Eve at the age of 99.

I am 65 years and 4 months old. Betty was a couple of weeks shy of turning 100. The way the math works, if I live to be as old as Betty White I have until around August 30, 2056 which is 34 more years and some change. My oldest daughter will be 74 years old then! My youngest grandchildren, the twins, Thomas and Olivia, will be 37 years old and well into their adult lives. Will I have more grandchildren? How many great-grandchildren will I welcome into the world before 2056?

I have worked steadily since the age of 10! How many more years of working do I have left in me? I am eligible for full social security in a year or so. Could I stand to be just a retired person for my last 33 years?

How many more miles can I put on my bicycle? I am almost at 41,000 miles now. Can I still rack up thousands of miles a year into my eighties and nineties?

I like to read. I read about 50 books a year. That would leave me about 1,700 titles to finish up. I probably have that many books in my house now, which means if I never buy another book I will still have enough to read; but of course I will probably buy that many again in the next 30 years or so!

What will the world look like in 2056? What will be the state of the country, our Church, the world? Is Social Security even going to be around for me to dip into when I finally do retire?

Of course, the big assumption here is that I get to live as long as Betty did. Insurance agents, pension boards and social security works are betting on me taking that final leap in the next 15 years or so. If I live past that, I am costing them money!

So when will that last day happen? The truth is, of course that I have no idea. God knows but He ain't telling. Maybe I will be gone by this time next year. Maybe I will break Betty's record and live into the 2060s! And in that pondering is the mystery of our life on earth and the continuation of our soul's life beyond the mortal veil: You must live each day as if it were your last, while at the same time prepare each day as if there will be another one in the morning. If you are someone who likes to be organized and plan things, this should drive you crazy. Fortunately for me, my life has had more twists than a long piece of licorice, so I am okay with the uncertainty.

God gives each of us a life. From my understanding, we are to make of that gift what we can. We are to be there for each other each day, while at the same time prepare every day to meet Him face to face and, hopefully, share eternity with Him. One foot in our day to day existence, one foot over the edge of the cliff. Are you planners tearing your hair out yet?

From what I have read about Betty White, she made the most of her 99+ years. She continued to work as an actress, making audiences laugh. She was passionate about animals, and donated time and money towards the cause of their welfare.

Carlo Acutis, on the other hand, was a young Italian lad who died at the tragic age of 15. He is on track to be named a saint, and the talk is that once named, he will, because of what he was able to accomplish in his young life, be assigned as the "Saint of the internet." It certainly can be said that he made the most of his much shorter 15 years of life.

There is, in all of us I think, a desire to live to be as old as Betty White and to die in our sleep peacefully at a very old age. But, however and whenever our time comes, we know one thing for certain: that time will indeed come. We will pass on from this life one day. The question we must contemplate is how well do we live that life? How many times do we add to the lives of the people with whom we come in contact? Is it positive or negative? Do we help to build His Kingdom or do we work towards tearing it down?

As we begin the year 2022, let us live as if we still have many years to go. At the same time, may we live as if we will meet our Creator before the sun rises!
