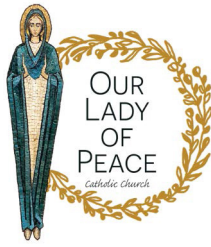

The Our Lady of Peace Open Shelter Support Group is again creating Easter baskets for homeless and marginally housed children.


