24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 15, 2019

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

"Let us celebrate with a feast, because this son of mine was dead, and has come back to life again; he was lost, and has been found." Then the celebration began. [Luke 15:24]

Jesus tells the grumbling Pharisees and scribes 3 parables and each follows a similar pattern. There is loss, search, finding, and finally rejoicing. In our human weakness so often we only focus on the first two moments. Then and now, this is what gives religion a bad name, why self-righteous religious folks are not pleased with Jesus' association with sinners. The lost being found needs to be publicly celebrated; their straying hurt not only them but the entire faith community. In rejoicing the community is rebuilt and healed.

Have you ever grumbled or judged someone who comes to Holy Communion when they only come to church once or twice a year? I have. Does our community practice the hospitality of Jesus who welcomed all with joy, love, and compassion? Do we really follow Jesus if we do not seek the lost and welcome the sinner? Pope Francis is fond of saying that the Eucharist is not a reward for virtue, as much as it is healing for the wounded, food for the hungry, and medicine for the soul.

This weekend we honor our catechists who seek out our children and share the Gospel with them and teach them to rejoice in God's ways. We commission our Catechists and bless them as well as our parents and godparents in their role as teachers of faith. Also we ponder those who have served Christ in our parish and nominate someone for the Bishop Gartland Service Award. Whose example has moved and inspired you to serve God?

Question for the week: Where has God sought you out, found you and brought you home? Who is lost in your family or faith community? How is God calling you to seek them?

Word for the week: "celebratory:" one who is drawn to rejoice with those who have found new life and hope. The Prodigal Father runs out to meet his son; he can't wait to celebrate his homecoming and is not particularly interested in the son's repentance, but only in having him back alive.

Estimados feligreses y amigos:

"Celebremos con una fiesta, porque este hijo mío estaba muerto, y ha vuelto a la vida; se perdió, y ha sido encontrado. Entonces comenzó la celebración. [Lucas 15:24]

Jesús nos cuenta 3 parábolas de los fariseos y escribas quejándose y cada uno sigue un patrón similar. Hay pérdida, búsqueda, encuentro, y finalmente regocijo. En nuestra debilidad humana tan a menudo sólo nos centramos en los dos primeros momentos. Entonces y ahora, esto es lo que le da a la religión un mal nombre, por qué los religiosos auto justos no están complacidos con la asociación de Jesús con los pecadores. El ser perdido necesita ser celebrado públicamente; su desviación no los lastimó solamente a ellos, sino a toda la comunidad de fe. En el regocijo, la comunidad es reconstruida y sanada.

¿Alguna vez se quejó o juzgó a alguien que viene a la Santa Comunión cuando sólo viene a la iglesia una o dos veces al año? Yo lo he hecho ¿Practica nuestra comunidad la hospitalidad de Jesús que acogió a todos con alegría, amor y compasión? ¿Realmente seguimos a Jesús si no buscamos a los perdidos y damos la bienvenida al pecador? El Papa Francisco es aficionado a decir que la Eucaristía no es tanto una recompensa por la virtud, como la curación para los heridos, la comida para los hambrientos y la medicina para el alma.

Este fin de semana honramos a nuestros catequistas que educan a nuestros hijos y comparten el Evangelio con ellos y les enseñan a regocijarse en los caminos de Dios. Encomendamos a nuestros catequistas y los bendecimos a ellos, así como a nuestros padres y padrinos en su papel de maestros de fe. También meditamos en aquellos que han servido a Cristo en nuestra parroquia y nominamos a alguien para el Premio al Servicio del Obispo Gartland. ¿De quién es el ejemplo que os ha inspirado a servir a Dios?

Pregunta para la semana: *¿Te ha buscado Dios, te ha encontrado y te ha traído a casa? ¿Quién se pierde en su familia o comunidad de fe? ¿Cómo te está llamando Dios a buscarlos?*

Palabra para la semana: "celebratorio:" *uno que se siente atraído a regocijarse con aquellos que han encontrado nueva vida y esperanza. El Padre Pródigo sale corriendo a encontrarse con su hijo; no puede esperar para celebrar su regreso a casa y no está particularmente interesado en el arrepentimiento del hijo, sino sólo en tenerlo de vuelta con vida.*

You have until September 28, 2019 to submit your prayers/intentions.

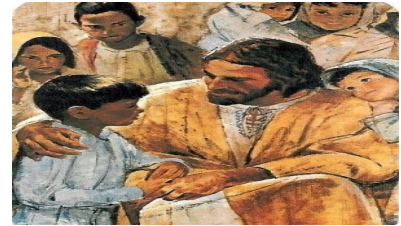

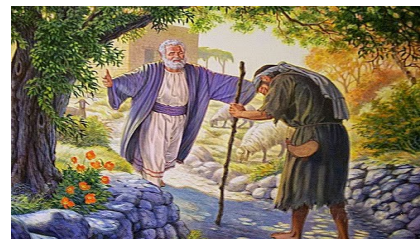

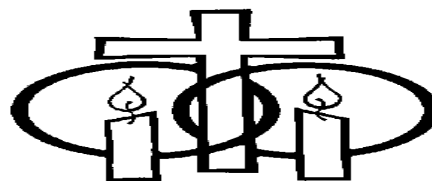

The world would not hear about the newly declared International Day of Peace. The initiator of the project, Jeremy Gilley, was very discouraged, but he decided to stay with his dream and keep pushing his idea in as many countries as he could get to. In 2007, the Taliban in Afghanistan ceased all fighting and allowed 1.6 million children to be vaccinated against polio on September 21st that year. En 2007, el Talibán en Afganistán paró toda batalla y permitió que 1.6 millones de niños fueran vacunados contra el polio el 21 de septiembre ese año. Jeremy continúa su trabajo de paro de hostilidades en un nivel global, paro de toda violencia y guerra el 21 de septiembre.

Godparent or Parent of a child to be Baptized? Remember to make an appointment to attend the Baptism Classes [with Fr. Bob or Ana Velez]. Then you can set a date for your Baptism. If you are going to be participating in a Baptism in another parish or another state, you will need a letter of reference stating that you have completed the class and that you are a parishioner in good standing. [If you are not registered as a parishioner you cannot be a parishioner in good standing.]

When do we celebrate Baptisms? Baptisms can be celebrated during Mass on Saturday or Sunday. Other Baptisms can be scheduled on any day of the week, but many people like to celebrate on Saturday afternoons, then party with the community. Fr. Bob gives out the Baptismal Certificates to the couples when they present the baptized babies to the community the following week at Mass.
