#### Scripture Readings January 8, 2022 The Epiphany of the Lord

First Reading: Isaiah 60:1-6

Jerusalem is extolled as a place of glory and splendor because the Lord has come to His own city.

#### Second Reading: Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6

Paul tells the Ephesians that his special mission is to make the Gentiles co-heirs with the Jews in Christ — "members of the same body and sharers of the promise."

#### Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12

Herod learns that Wise Men from the East are searching for the newly born Christ Child. He instructs them to find the Child and to report His whereabouts to him. The Wise Men follow a star to the place where Mary and Jesus are and offer the Child gold, frankincense, and myrrh. They do not return to Herod but follow another route to their own country.

#### **January 8 - Epiphany**

The traditional date of Epiphany is January 6, but in the United States,



it is celebrated on the Sunday between January 2 and 8.

Some communities have the custom of blessing their homes with recalling the visit of the Magi. The household gathers at the manger scene to read Matthew 2:1-12. The light of the star guided the Three Kings on their journey. We too, must be lights for each other. Think of ways we can help others as we journey along in life.

House blessing: Lord, God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

With chalk, mark the lintel over the main door of the house: 20 + C + M + B + 23

The numbers are those of the New Year (2023), the first initials of the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. The crosses stand for the four seasons.
