

(19 or more are needed to ensure that we will be able to receive any money donated over our goal and to apply for an abatement if we do not reach our goal). Reflections on our Pastoral Collaborative from Parish Pastoral Council Members

Members of the PPC want to make sure our parish is as ready as it can be for the change in parish life coming this June when our Pastoral Collaborative with St. Michael's begins. This weekend we are beginning a series of bulletin inserts written by PPC members. They touch upon important topics for discussion as we move into becoming a Collaborative with St. Michael Parish.

Today's insert is on openness to the Holy Spirit, written by PPC member and Cantor, Katie Broach. The PPC felt that with the anxiety and fear of change which many may experience, we need to center our situation from within the plan of God for our Pastoral Collaborative. An openness to where the Holy Spirit is leading us may help with our own individual concerns and anxiousness about what is soon to happen.

I invite every parishioner to read over Katie's presentation and bring it to prayer over the next few weeks as we move towards the establishment of our Collaborative.

Our Celebrations of Holy Week and Easter Needs You!

We are approaching the holiest days of our church year. Soon we will celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and then join him at the Last Supper on Holy Thursday as he gives us his body and blood, and, by washing the disciples' feet, gives us a model of service. On Good Friday we will hear once again the story of his passion and death and venerate his cross. Then, on Holy Saturday we will celebrate his resurrection and the Sacrament of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) at the Great Easter Vigil. We will finish up the Paschal Triduum on Easter Sunday with the joyous masses of Easter.

To celebrate these moments well, our parish has assembled a number of parishioners who make up our Holy Week and Triduum preparation team. They are hard at work getting everything ready so that our celebrations will be prayerful and meaningful. *They need your help!*

There are a number of liturgical ministries that need to be filled. If you've ever wanted to be an altar server, a thurifer, a greeter, etc.... now is your chance! Your commitment would be for one of the services of Holy Week that are spelled out in today's second bulletin insert. You will be given all the instruction needed to fulfill your role, and there will be a rehearsal just before Holy Week. Please take a look at the insert and pray about becoming a part of the liturgical ministry of the great Feast of Easter.

CORI PROCESSING

There are 3 options for verifying your information:

- 2. Make an appointment with the Parish Office to do your CORI verification in-person with a staff member.
- 3. Have your CORI form verified by a Notary prior to submission. You will also need to verify receipt of the updated Code of Ministerial Behavior for the Archdiocese of Boston. This will be done by mail or e-mail once the CORI has been submitted.

PETER BROCKMANN, DIRECTOR OF MUSIC

Well, we're in the full swing of Lent. This is the Third Sunday of the season, and the third time our gathering song is RAISE US UP, by Fr Fran.

And it won't be the last. We will sing this song as the gathering for the Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, too. Although you might think it a bit tedious to do that, I'm hoping that we can move past that emotion and get to a deeper and different response to the music. Instead, I hope that with this repetition of the song, like hitting the nail with the hammer a third, fourth and fifth time, the message of the lyric will sink in a little deeper each time. I hope that you might review the lyric again and within the musical structure of the refrain and verses, sincerely call on God to 'Change our hearts; heal our lives. Raise us up from the ashes again.'

Also, Fr Fran has crafted a third verse that points to the message of today's gospel from John - Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well.

So, we'll be singing the familiar refrain, verse 1 refrain and then the new 3rd verse and refrain. This will become our pattern gathering song for the next three weeks. Next week, we'll substitute the fourth verse and so on. Let us sing!


