

Feast of the Assumption of Mary Tuesday, August 15th

The Feast of the Assumption celebrates Mary's welcome, body and soul, into heaven. As Jesus was first to rise from the dead, he has received his mother first into eternity. For her, the resurrection of the dead has taken place already! Although it was only in 1950 that Pope Pius XII declared as dogma the bodily assumption of Mary into heaven, this feast has been celebrated on August 15 since the middle of the fifth century.

The placement of this feast, at the height of summer in the northern hemisphere, calls to mind the beginning of the harvest, the gathering in of the fruits of the earth. Mary's assumption is seen as the beginning of the great gathering into heaven of the faithful.

The Assumption is a feast to celebrate Mary as the first disciple to follow in the footsteps of her son, Jesus. Where he is, so too is his mother. We will one day follow in her footsteps as we enter into the loving embrace of Christ forever. Let us celebrate Mary as a role model of discipleship. May we follow her example of openness to God, and may we trust in God as faithfully and deeply as she did.

A NOTE FROM OUR MUSIC DIRECTOR PETER BROCKMANN

Our Gathering song this weekend is the famous "How Can I Keep From Singing?", 598 Gather 2, with music by Robert Lowry. The lyrics were authored by someone in the 1860s known only as 'Pauline T'. It was first published in the USA in 1869 as part of the songbook "Bright Jewels for the Sunday School", and in a periodical in Britain the same year. However, during the first three-quarters of the 20th century, the song was not widely used for congregational singing.

Apparently Doris Plenn, a friend of Pete Seeger, the folk singer learned the original song from her grandmother, and taught it to Pete, who popularized it in the 1960s. Seeger's version omitted much of the overtly Christian wording of the original, adding a verse by Doris (not available in our Christian version) about 'when tyrants tremble, sick with fear...", which supposedly referenced the 'witch hunts' of the House Un-American Activities Committee of the 1950s.

In 1991, the Irish singer Enya released a recording of this song which climbed to the top 50 in Australia, Sweden, Ireland and the UK. Her music video of this song includes an Irish church as a backdrop, and various world political figures and images. Among US Catholics, the song rose quickly in popularity with OCP publishing the song in the 'Spirit and Song' series in 1999, and GIA in Gather 2 in 2004. Our eldest daughter, Margaret, chose this song for her send forth song at her wedding mass in 2011. And as you might recall, Fr Fran has used Robert Lowry's music as the motif in an unpublished Mass setting (How Can I Keep From Singing? Mass) that we have used in previous summers and that we're planning to use later this calendar year. Let us sing!


