

From Fr. Fran

Welcome Back!

All are invited to our "welcome back" parish celebration after the 10 AM Mass this Sunday, September 24th. This will be a great opportunity to get together, reconnect, and make new friends as the fall season takes shape in our lives and in the life of our parish.

Blessing of the Animals

Next Sunday, October 1st, we will celebrate our annual Blessing of Animals at noon in the courtyard between the church and the parish offices. The Blessing of Animals honors St. Francis whose feast day is October 4th. He was well known for his love of and relationship with animals along with his tireless work with the poor and the outcast of his day. Always a highlight of our year, come with the four- and two-legged family members who bring so much joy to our lives!

Faith Formation

Also, next weekend, we begin our **Faith Formation sessions** for the year. Please pray for the youngsters and their catechists as they learn to grow as faithful disciples of Christ through their exploration of the scriptures and the traditions of the church.

Sometimes we mistake Faith Formation for another "class", and indeed that's what it was in the past. Those of a certain age will recall going to "Sunday School". Those of another generation will recall participating in "CCD classes". (a Dunkin Donuts gift card will go to the first person who e mails me with the correct answer to what CCD stands for.)

Back then the emphasis was on learning the rules and regulations of the Catholic Church rather than learning how to develop the virtues and understand the responsibilities flowing from our baptism. In the change of title to "Faith Formation" we see that the emphasis now is on forming the next generation of Catholics into people of faith and action on behalf of Christ.

Parish Finances

Our Parish Finance Council is putting the final touches on this year's report to the parish for the fiscal year 2023. Next weekend we will have a bulletin insert with all the stats. As a preview, let me say that, along with a number of other parishes, financial recovery from the pandemic has been a struggle. You will see that we ended the year with a significant deficit.

In order not to repeat this for FY 2024, the Finance Council has forecasted that, if we hit our 4 thousand dollar per week Offertory goal with consistency, we will end next year with a small surplus.

I know that with continued high inflation it's tough for all of us to make ends meet. It's the same with St. Matthias Parish. Please prayerfully consider increasing your weekly donation at this time so that we can continue to provide the services and ministries that we have now.

One of our greatest challenges in the near future will be financing a number of **major repairs to our church building**. As I have mentioned on numerous occasions, our roof needs replacing and the front stairs to the church need to be reset after the leaking façade above them is repaired. More about this in weeks to come!

We have a number of **faithful parishioners** who have been **struggling** with physical ailments over the last few months. Please keep all of our ill parishioners in your prayers. With illness often comes great psychological as well as physical challenges. Through the presence of the Holy Spirit, may our friends find inner peace and strength during their illnesses. May they be assured that their fellow parishioners continue to hold them in prayer.




