A NOTE FROM OUR MUSIC DIRECTOR PETER BROCKMANN

Our Gathering song this weekend is an unpublished melody by our pastor and resident composer, Fr Fran O'Brien. The lyric is *Arise, Your Light Has Come* by Ruth C. Duck.

Ruth Duck (born 1947), was ordained in the United Church of Christ and retired as professor of worship at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in Evanston, Illinois, in 2016. Dr Duck, is best known as a composer and writer of hymns, having written over 150 hymns and three books of resources for worship by 2015. Her speciality is facilitating the use of gender-inclusive language in Christian worship. Before studying for her PhD (Boston University School of Theology, awarded 1989), in her time as a minister (1974-1989) she noticed that the language used in worship books and hymnals referred to God, almost exclusively, in the masculine.

She argues in her books and career that God is bigger than any one gender and deserves a more inclusive and expansive vision of the divine mystery and makes all human beings visible.

In Gather 2, she provided lyrics in 11 hymns, including *As a Fire is Meant for Burning* and *Diverse in Culture, Nation, Race* (which Fr Fran also wrote a separate melody).
