

BE A CATECHIST, SAVE A SOUL! St. Jude Thaddeus desperately needs catechists for the Kindergarten and 3rd & 4th grade combined class. Aides are also required for each class. Classes begin on September 12th and are from 9:30a until 10:40a each Sunday.

RCIA: A JOURNEY OF FAITH: Since Jesus invited His



first followers to "Come, follow me," the image of the journey has been used to describe Christian discipleship. For each of us, faith is a journey marked with moments of conversion along the way. We move from unbelief to initial

faith, from sin to repentance, from painful isolation to the joyful experience of a loving community, from fear to love.

Faith, conversion, repentance, celebration, and community are the five essential elements in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA provides a setting where the journey of faith and moments of conversion can be celebrated within the local Church community. The purpose of RCIA is literally "the making of Christians," for as Tertullian in the 4th century wrote, "Christians are made, not born."

Join us on the journey. This invitation is extended to:

- anyone who has never been baptized
- anyone who is affiliated with any church and has a desire to be a member of a church community
- anyone who has been baptized in another denomination but is interested in learning about the Catholic faith
- any non-active Catholic who has been away from the Church and would like to get re-acquainted
- any adult Catholic who would like to learn more about the Church and mature in their faith

CHILDREN'S COLLECTION: The Children's Collection is a wonderful way to introduce our young ones to the practice of stewardship and tithing. It is also an opportunity to help them learn about the virtues of piety and reverence. Parents, please practice with your precious young ones the proper way to bring their offering to the Altar of God:

- 1. walk, not run down the aisle
- 2. make a deep bow of reverence to the altar
- 3. put their offering into the basket
- 4. walk, not run back to their pew

ASK FATHER!

Have a question for Father? Liturgical, Theological, Spiritual, Philosophical, Scriptural, or Canonical...all are on the table. Just send him an email. Once a week, he will pick a question to answer here in the bulletin.

This Week's Question: Confession is hard for some folks because it can be embarrassing or shameful. How can you help us feel more comfortable going?

Father Says: You bet! Firstly, try to remember it is not me you are coming to see in the confessional, but rather the Divine Physician of souls, our Merciful Savior, Jesus Christ. Scripture is full of how merciful He is, and how He longs for you to see Him:

- "God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us." Ephesians 2:4
- "The Lord is slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, forgiving iniquity and transgression." Numbers 14:18
- "Return to the Lord, your God, for he is gracious and merciful." Joel 2:13
- "I thirst." John 19:28
- "As the deer longs for flowing streams, so my soul longs for you." Psalm 42:1
- "It is I; do not be afraid." John 6:20

Secondly, as for embarrassment or shame...those are from Satan and meant to discourage you from reconciling with God. Refuse to give in. Some helpful secrets about confession I can share with you:

- You will not confess something I have not already heard. I guarantee 100% you will not invent a new sin.
- Sins are boring. I do not remember them outside the confessional. It is a grace Jesus grants to his priests.
- I DO remember, however, the bountiful joy at seeing a soul reconciled with God! I LOVE seeing when the crushing burden of sin is lifted off the shoulders of a penitent. Beautiful!
- I cannot reveal ANYTHING about a confession to anyone for any reason. I will give my life to protect the seal of the confessional.

Please keep in mind that the confessional is a field hospital for sinners. We are ALL sinners. None of us is worthy of the love of God, nor deserving of His mercy. That is why it is called 'grace' – it is a feely-given, undeserved gift from the God who loves us so much, He became one of us and died for us. Be not afraid! See you soon...


