

## Pastoral Council Meeting

March 3, 2016

Present: Fr. Khoi, Marge Poole, Dave Poole, Steve Booker, Greg Leonard, Linda Gibson, Tammy Gerstner

- Renovation Proposal
  - Fr. Khoi presented the Summary Project Proposal he will be submitting to the Diocese.
  - We voted to proceed with the whole project running approximately \$320,000. We cannot proceed until we have around \$140-160,000 in cash.
  - Marge Poole talked about doing a Dinner of Donors. Will talk about fund raising at the next Building Committee meeting.
  - Fr. Khoi will write a letter and encourage people to donate money to the building fund and begin the saving process.
    - He will not touch the money in our savings - Rainy Day Fund.
  - Other items pertinent to the Parish Hall renovation:
    1. Flooring - will put new flooring over old to save the cost of tearing out the old.
    2. Fire suppression hood over the new stove - around \$6000.
    3. Cabinets - it is more cost effective to pull out and replace with new ones. The old ones are not ADA compliant.
    4. The HVAC will pay for itself in 3 years.
  - First, Fr. Khoi will work with the architect to finalize plans. He will present to the Diocese for approval, then we will do fundraising.
- Vacation Bible School
  - Will hold the week of June 13-17.
  - Gillis agreed to be the coordinator. The first planning meeting will be this month.
  - There will be a \$10 fee for the T-shirt.
  - No stapling decorations on the walls - too many little holes.
- Family Fun Day
  - June 19, at the Burkburnett Aquatic Center, 6:30 to 8:30
  - Planning for 100
  - Will meet at the park at 5:00 for dinner, then go over to the Aquatic Center.
  - We may invite the other parishes also.
- Other Businesses
  - Work on repairing the cracks in the ceiling and walls in the Church will begin March 14. Fr. Khoi wants it completed by Easter.
  - March 11, the Youth will be doing Stations of the Cross.

- Fr. Khoi talked about creating a lot of opportunities for the youth. We need to keep encouraging participation - don't give up.
- Dave Poole suggested we advertise upcoming events earlier so people have more time to plan, and hear about events more than once.
- Fr. Khoi also wants to have more support for young families. He wants to build circles of support and community, not just programs.
- Fr. Khoi asked for suggestions on any good Christian based speakers we can bring in.
- Holy Thursday - Fr. Khoi wants 4 representatives from each of his 3 parishes to participate in the washing of the feet. Will be at Christ the King.
- March 20, we are hosting the Community Palm Sunday service at 6:00 pm.
- Next time we meet, Fr. Khoi would like names of people who may be interested in heading up the Fall Festival. He said in Denton they had a rotating system.
