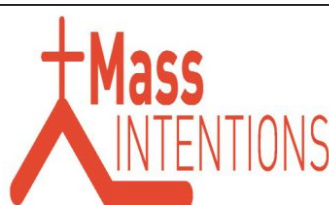

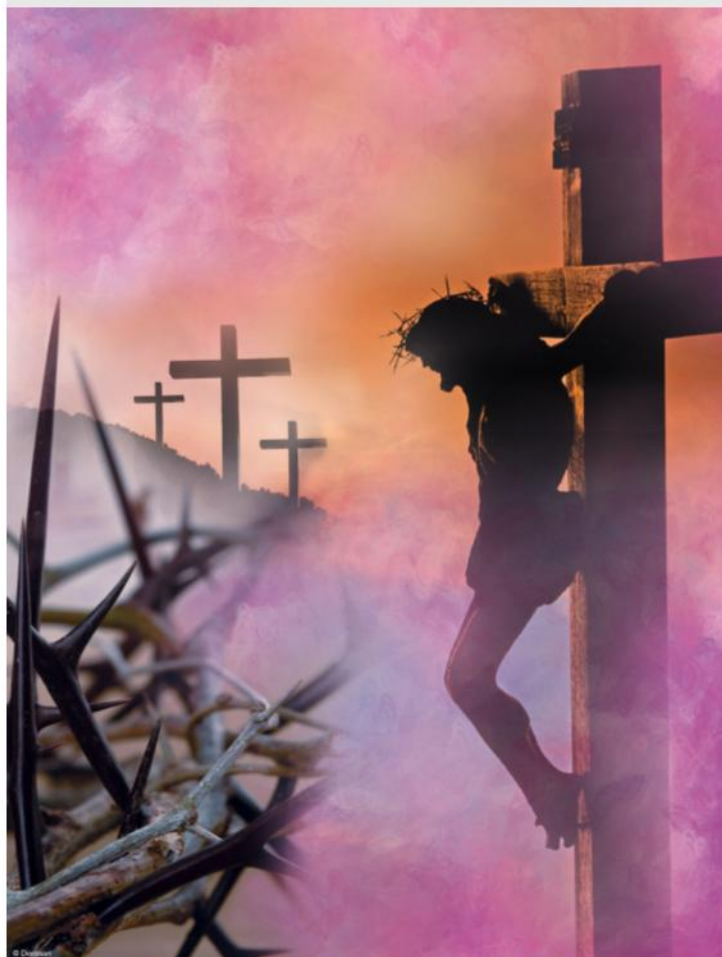

RECEPTION OF THE SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM Infants and children below the age of 7

Parents and Godparents must attend a baptismal preparation session before scheduling a Baptism. During the pandemic, contact the parish office to find out when the next class will take place.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION



- ♦ Baptism (above age 7)
- ♦ First Reconciliation
- ♦ First Holy Communion
- ♦ Confirmation

For the Sacraments of **Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation** there must be at least one to two years of Christian formation prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Adults and children of catechetical age (above age 7) are welcomed into the Catholic Church through a process called the **Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA)**.

This process prepares a person for Baptism and/or the sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation. Anyone **wishing to join the Church or to complete initiation** into the Church should call the parish office.

For **adults** who have **lived their Catholic faith** but have **not received the sacrament of Confirmation**, call the parish office for information about the yearly Diocesan-wide Confirmation Mass.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

If someone is seriously ill or is scheduled to have surgery, please call the parish office for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

Note: Due to the Privacy (HIPAA) Laws, hospitals **will not** notify us if you or your loved one is admitted. A family member must notify us if you wish for one of the priests to visit you in the hospital.



MARRIAGE

Couples should discuss preparation arrangements with the priest at least six months prior to setting a wedding date.

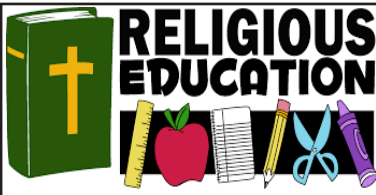

CATHOLIC 201

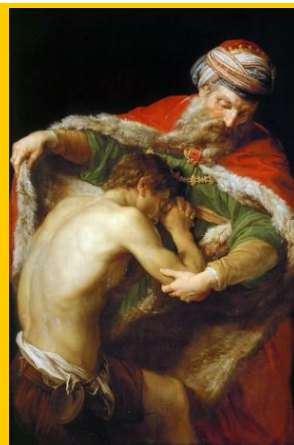

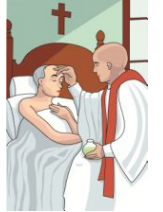
SACRAMENTO DEL MATRIMONIO
