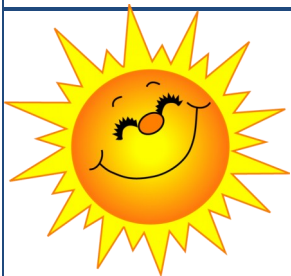
### **All Souls Altar of Remembrance**
