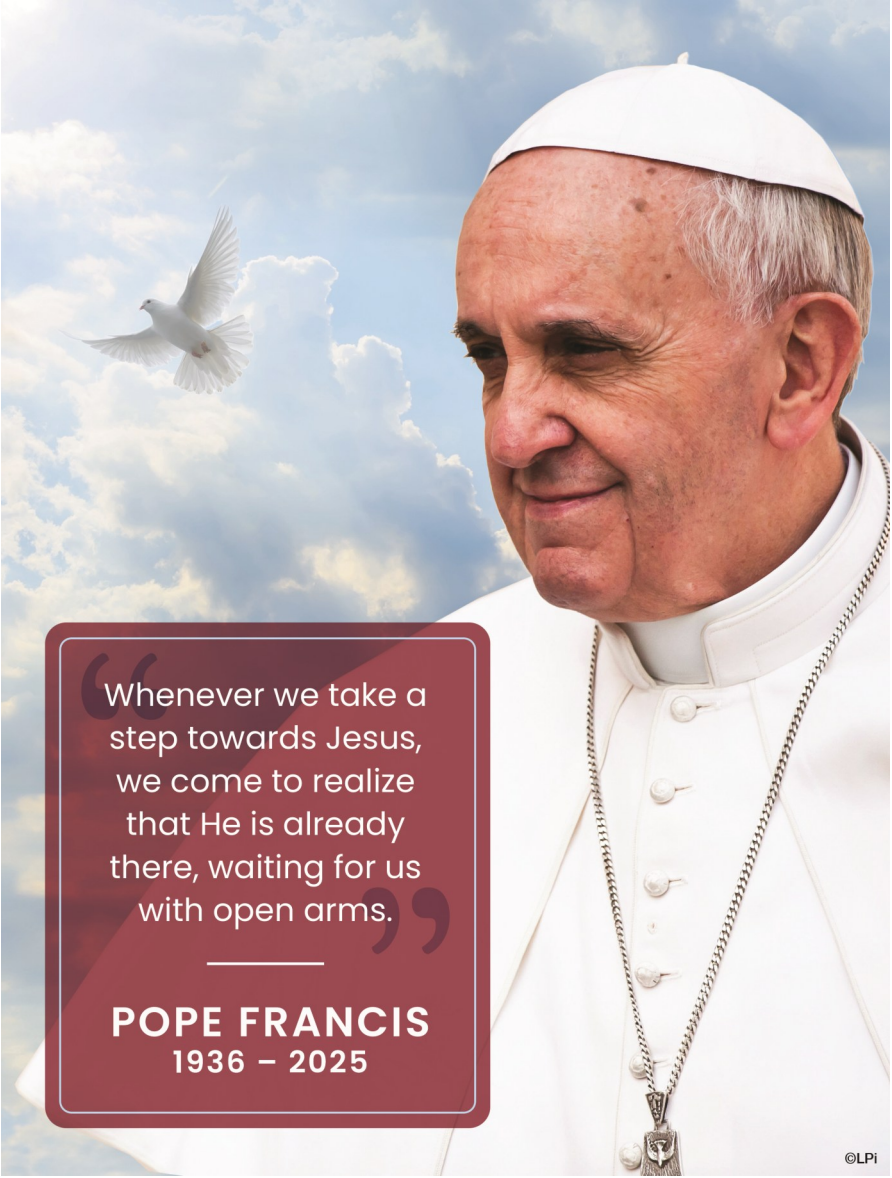

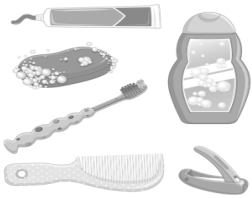

Taking Ownership of Our Parish — Part IV

Evangelization: By taking ownership of our faith through our faith formation within our parish, we become ambassadors of faith for our parish and the Catholic Church. Jesus Christ made all of us evangelists when he instructed us to “Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the ends of the earth” (Mark 16:15).
