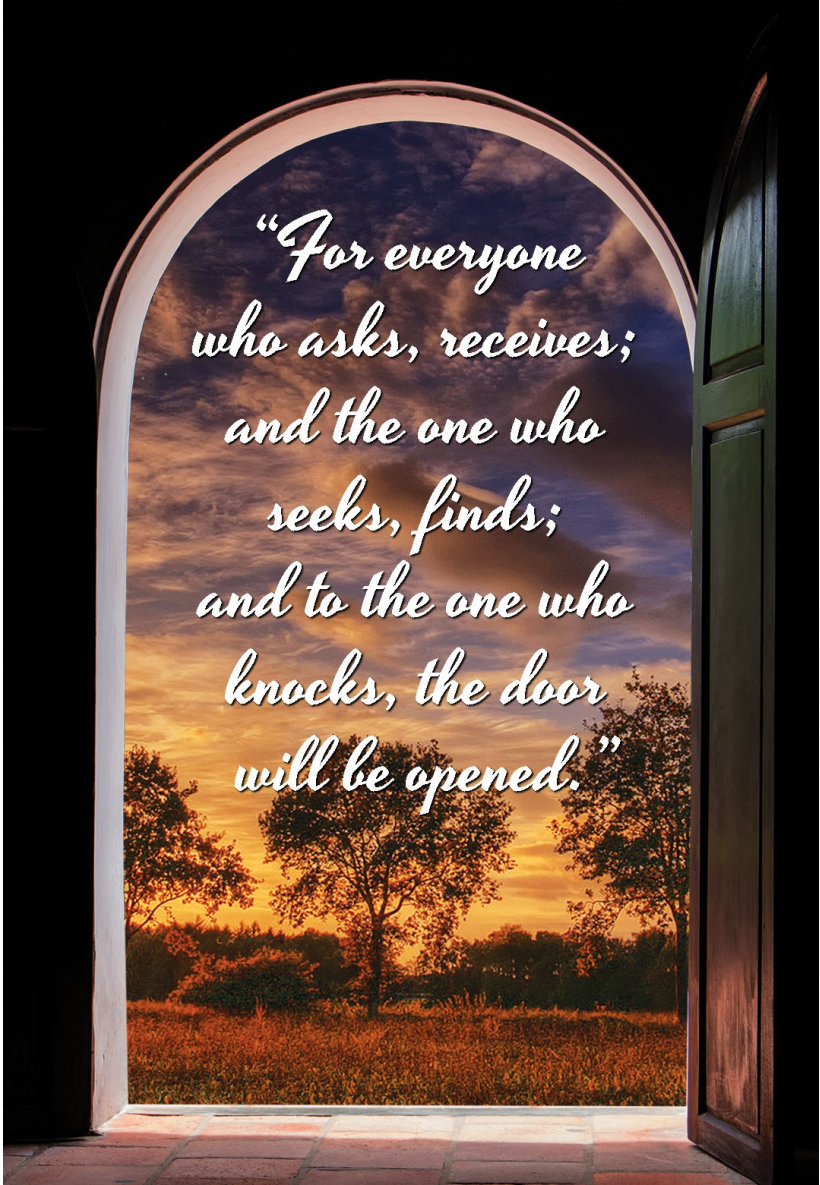

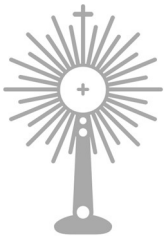

Restore the House of God: Help Needed
We would like to thank **Tony and Karen Guerra** for accepting responsibility for the roof repairs. May God increase their talents, gifts, and skills to continue to serve God's people, and increase His blessings upon them for their zeal to restore God's house, their spiritual home.

The next Godly restoration needed for our church is the following:

Ceiling tile replacement: Some water stained ceiling tiles in the east, front offices, table storage room, and in the entrance to the worship space (low ceiling area) need to be replaced - about 15 (2 foot X 2 foot) tiles in total. Most will have to be cut to fit ceiling grid. The task includes taking the stained one down, tracing the size on the new tile, cutting it, and placing the new one in the grid. You will need a utility knife and a straightedge -these can be provided for you. Ladders and ceiling tiles are provided.

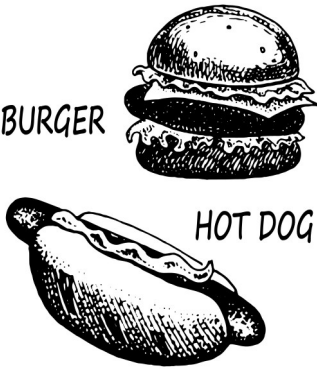
