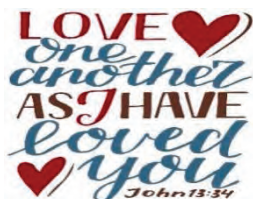
Gospel: John 13:31-33a, 34-35
