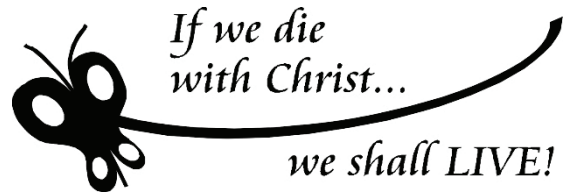

Paul explains to the Romans that by immersion in water at baptism, they "die" to their sins; by rising from the water, they rise from "death and sin" to new life in Christ.

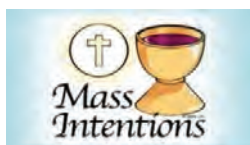
Gospel: Matthew 10:37-42

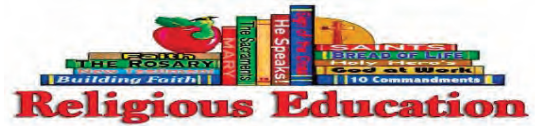


The 2024 Daily Mass Book will open on **Thursday, July 6th**. Please stop by or call the office to request a Mass

What is Religious Education/Faith Formation at St. Clement Church?

Religious Education at St. Clement Church is a **program** consisting of a yearly series of classes separated into Levels. The program might better be described as student "Faith Formation" because Religious Education classes educate students in the various principles, vocabulary, and practices of the Catholic faith helping them to **form** their Catholic **faith**.

Each year students are placed in a *Level* according to their age and grade and each Level focuses on a different Catholic principle. For example, one Level focuses on the Bible and the 10 Commandments, one Level focuses on the Sacraments, other Levels focus on prayer, Jesus, the Eucharist, forgiveness etc. Each class Level continues and builds on the previous one.

For a complete "Faith Formation" or Religious Education, student should start the program in 1st grade and continue through 8th grade completing all the Levels while also participating in community service, fellowship activities, Mass attendance, and Sacrament preparation. It is our goal that all students who complete the Religious Education program will:

- establish a loving relationship with Jesus.
- feel at home in St. Clement church and among our community.
- receive the Sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation, and Confirmation.
- have a firm understanding of our Catholic faith.
- discover their role as a Catholic person.
