Begin each Rosary with these prayers:

The Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Apostle's Creed

I Believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth.
And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit
born of the Virgin Mary, Suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.
He descended into hell; On the third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into Heaven,
And is seated at the right hand of God, the Father almighty;
From there he shall come to judge the living and the dead.
I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church,
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting, Amen.

Our Father

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed by thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day, our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not
into temptation but deliver us from evil, Amen.

Three Hail Mary's (for an increase of faith, hope and charity)

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee.
Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.
Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

The Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Then depending upon the day of the week,

choose one of the following four Mysteries of the Rosary to meditate on and pray:

Joyful (Monday/Saturday); Luminous (Thursday); Sorrowful (Tuesday/Friday); Glorious (Wednesday/Sunday)

For each decade mystery, pray:

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Marys, Glory Be (Prayers above), Fatima Prayer: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell. Lead all souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy mercy.

After the fifth decade, pray the following CONCLUDING prayers:

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To Thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To Thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb Jesus. O clement, O loving, o sweet Virgin Mary!
Pray for us, O most holy Mother of God,
That we may be worthy of the promised of Christ

In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.
