- 11pm: lights out























- Attend 4pm mass in matching shirts!




- Door Repair, Repair Basement Steps/Railing, General Repairs: 5 Days

- 3. Replace leaking roof, Building overhang over back door: 5 Days
- 4. Install Gutters: 2 Days
- 5. Deck Repair or Replacement, Replace Several Windows: 4-5 Days
- 6. Replace bedroom subflooring, install new linoleum flooring: 5 Days
- 7. Replace Front Door, Replace 2 Windows: 2 Days
- 8. Replace Deck Boards on Ramp, Possible roof repair: 2-3 Days
- 9. Power wash/Stain Deck/Handicap Ramp, Repair Storm Door :2-3 Days
- 10. Repair Front window and damaged soffit: 1 Day
- 11. Install handicap accessible/walk in shower: 5 Days




