First Communion/Confirmation

First Communion & Confirmation are special sacraments that we help students prepare for. Students typically celebrate first communion during 2nd grade, but we also welcome older children that have not yet celebrated. Confirmation students must be in High School when the sacrament is received.

Preparation is a 2-year commitment and includes: class preparation, reconciliation, parent meetings, attendance at Mass, and practice time. **A student must attend one year of classes here at Immaculate Conception prior to the year they will be celebrating a sacrament.**

The reason that we require a two consecutive year program is because celebration a sacrament should involve becoming familiar and comfortable with our parish community. Class participation is an important part of our program. Students that attend our classes have the opportunity to meet peers and share their faith, work in small groups, become familiar with our facility, and take class visits to the church. They will also experience opportunities to meet our priest, develop relationships with catechists, learn how they can become involved volunteering at the church, and enjoy the benefits of a structured classroom setting.

These changes have been in effect since the 2011-2012 school year.

All teachers/aides undergo background screening, Virtus training and agree to abide by the diocesan code of conduct.

The children also attend safety classes.
