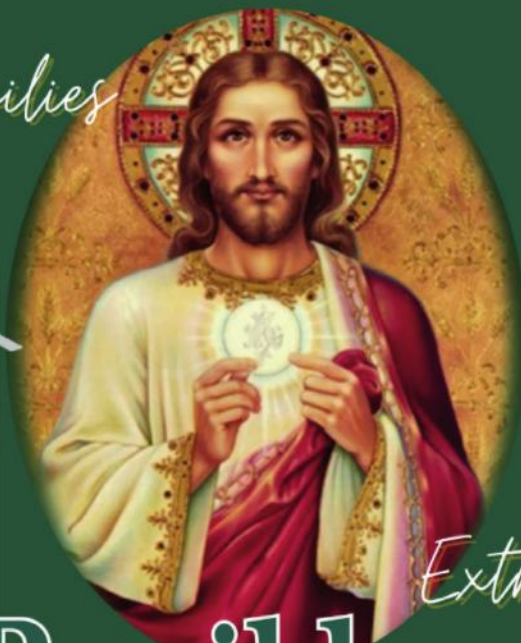

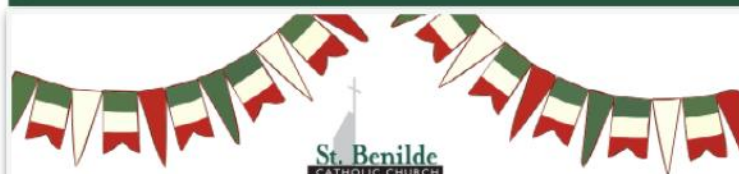

Today, David chairs and teaches theology at Archbishop Rummel High School, having moved here from California with his wife, Rebecca, and family.

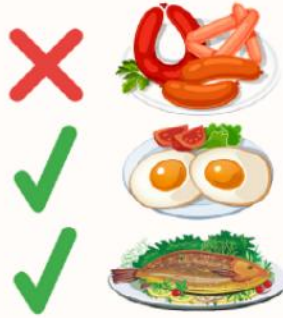

GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF



FASTING

- for ages 18-59 years old
- eat 1 regular meal and 2 small meals (should not exceed the main amount of the main meal)



ABSTINENCE

- for ages 14 years old and above
- refraining from kinds of food or drink
- refrain from eating meat (i.e. flesh and organs of mammals and birds), but may consume fish and shellfish

This year, Good Friday is March 29—the day when we commemorate Christ's passion, suffering and death. This is a solemn day of prayer, fasting, and abstinence. See the graphic above for a breakdown of what this means for us Catholics.
