


An Update from Fr. Matthew dated 6/16/24:

Blessings my brothers and sisters,

This past week began with a bang. On Monday we were introduced to Land Navigation. We did both a day and night iteration. This meant that we were in formation for 0410 in the morning to ruck to the place for land navigation. We had classes in the morning to introduce us to it. In the afternoon we did the day iteration, and after sunset we did the night iteration. This meant that we did not leave land navigation until 2230 and did not get back to our hotels until nearly midnight. It made for a long day to say the least. The best part of this is that I was able to bring my Mass kit to offer Mass in the field where we were. In addition to the Catholic chaplains and seminarians joining us, we had nearly forty other chaplains of other denominations come and join us in prayer. It was a beautiful moment of witness and one that made the long day worth it.

Thankfully because of the very late night, we did not have to be in formation until 0645 on Tuesday morning. What a blessing! This was also the last full day of our DCC phase of the CHBOLC summer. We had class work in the morning and afternoon and prepared for our "graduation"



On Wednesday for 1000, we finally had our conclusion of DCC. No more drill sergeants. No more having to walk around with a camel back everywhere. No more battle buddies with us everywhere we went. Most importantly, we can start drinking caffeine again! Oh, how I missed that artificial stimulant to perk me up when I am tired.

On Friday we had the Chief of Chaplains come and speak with us. It was amazing to receive the wisdom of a two-star general who has served as a chaplain in the Army for over thirty years. He is an incredible man and one that many of us should strive to imitate, most especially in his dedication to soldiers. One thing that he told us that will always stick with me is this, "Be true to your call. God called you and wants you to live in and through that call." This is important, because I am Roman Catholic Priest and am actually doing a disservice


to myself and others if I try to be something I am not.

On Friday we also received an assignment to visit services of other faith denominations over the next few weeks. Keep in mind that they were not in any way asking us to participate and actually encouraged the opposite. They were just wanting us to see the different ways that the soldiers you will be ministering to worship. It was an enlightening experience, and I did learn a few things. Those words of the Chief of Chaplains also stuck with me as I experienced those other faith denominations.

As always, please know that I am praying for you. I was also saddened to hear that one of the priests who was supposed to cover a Mass did not show up for the vigil Mass on Saturday. Please know that I greatly apologize for that, and I pray that it does not happen again. I lift St. Benilde up in prayer every day. Once again feel free to send me your Mass intentions. God bless you.






