

# Fr. Matthew's Christmas Message

I know that some of my fondest memories involved getting together as a family for Christmas. We would go to my grandmother's house in Dallas and have a nice dinner on Christmas eve. We would then spend the next few hours doing puzzles and playing other board games until 11pm when we would walk to the local Catholic Church for carols until 12:00 a.m. when midnight Mass started. There may have been several times when I dozed off during the carols, but I would always strive to stay awake for the whole of the Mass.

Those memories have laid an important foundation for my love of the celebration of Christmas. Even though I may not have had the seminary formation I now do to be able to have a theological understanding of the hypostatic union (Jesus being fully man and fully divine), my parents instilled in me an excitement to want to come and celebrate Jesus' birthday. It is one that I still have today. I get excited every year to celebrate this wonderful and truly incredible feast.

My brothers and sisters, I would imagine that most if not all of us have certain ways that we have celebrated Christmas with our loved ones. I would hope that the excitement that those traditions once instilled in us continues to inspire us to properly enter into the great mystery of the Incarnation (Jesus taking on our human nature). We should smile. We should get butterflies. We should be able to share in some of that same enthusiasm that as a child made us count down the days until Christmas every year.

December 25<sup>th</sup> over 2000 years ago forever changed humanity. God reminded us of the love that He has for humanity when the Father sent His Son into the world all the while knowing the path that He must walk. I encourage all of us as we enter into this season to remember the "why" of it. It is because God loves us, period! I pray that even if we are not able to have the excitement we did as a child that we can take the time to let the truth of the day wash over us. Let us never forget what we celebrate, and just what it means for each and every one of us. Merry Christmas!

Is my information secure?
Yes! All of your data is transmitted across an encrypted Internet connection, and all of your personal information is stored in secure databases. Your information is never sold, rented, or given away to any third parties.

What if I don't have texting?

You can still sign up, as long as you have an e-mail address! We have a unique link on the

https://stbenildecatholicchurch.flocknote.com that you can also use to sign up. Just enter your name and e-mail address, and you can still receive all messages sent out by St. Benilde Church.

While Flocknote enables the clergy, staff, and ministry leaders of the parish to communicate more effectively with you. It will also enable you to control whether and how you receive communication from our parish ministries (by email, text, or not at all).

How do I access my options? When you register, you will be able to choose whether you would like to receive notes by email, text, or both, and the ministries you would like to join. To make changes, you can access your account at any time by using your email or phone, and password. The password can be created at the time of the registration or later.
