



St. Benilde's CYO will be hosting a solemn viewing of Mel' Gibson's *The Passion of Christ* in the Cafeteria beginning at 7:00 PM on Good Friday, April 18. This is open to any parishioner who would like to view the film as a way of further meditating on Christ's suffering, passion and death. However, because the film is rated R for violence, all individuals under 18 years of age must have a signed permission form to attend. Blank permission forms will be available upon entry.



**Tenebrae means "darkness" or "shadows"**, and it refers to the chanting of matins/lauds of the Divine Office on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

Usually, in religious orders, this part of the office is chanted when it is still dark outside, and sung by the light of candles only. In the earliest centuries, it was chanted shortly after midnight, but starting in the middle ages, it became the common practice to chant it on the evening before in anticipation, to make it more widely accessible to clergy and laity.

We will follow this tradition and make it available for parishioners. This year we will hold a Tenebrae service on Wednesday of Holy Week when the sun sets at 7:30pm. It will be roughly an hour in the candle-lit church.

What to Expect:

The cantor and Fr. Matthew will alternate the verses of the psalms. We as a congregation will have a booklet to follow along with. This will help us to know when it is our turn to speak or sing. There is a candle "hearse" at the front, shaped like a triangle, with seven candles. As each psalm is completed, one candle is extinguished, until only the lone candle at the top is left; this is a powerful reminder of the apostles abandoning Christ in his darkest hour.

Then, the candle representing Christ is hidden, so there is total darkness. This symbolizes the seemingly apparent victory of the forces of evil. A "loud noise/commotion" (the strepitus) is made, which represents the convulsion of nature following the death of Christ; the chaos of the world without a savior. This is done by the congregation banging their hands on pews for several seconds, until the "Christ candle" is returned to view again. Then all commotion ceases. And all depart in silence & darkness.

We urge you to consider coming if you haven't before, and experience this deeply moving, and prayerful part of Holy Week at St. Benilde. It helps us, as the lay faithful enter into Holy Week with a greater degree of contemplation. It is like a mini religious retreat for lay people.




