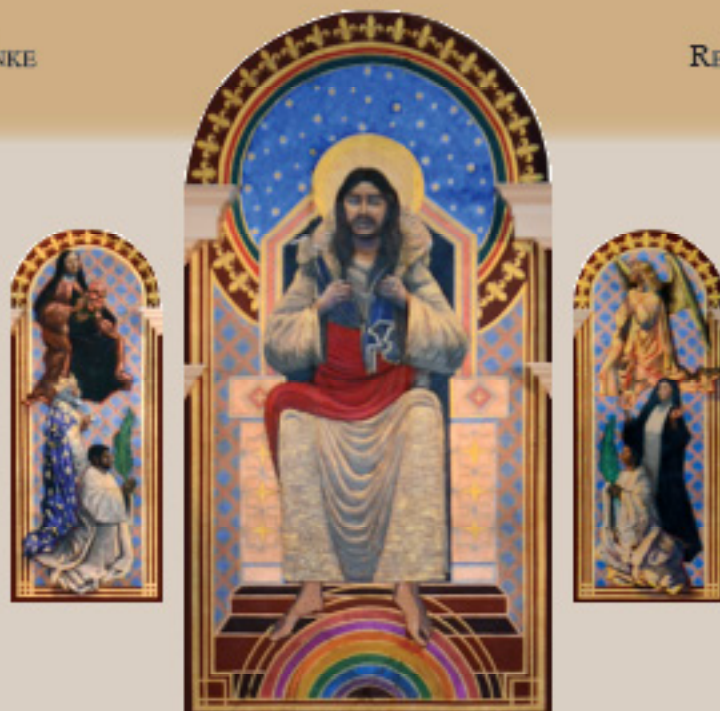

**BAPTISM PREPARATION**

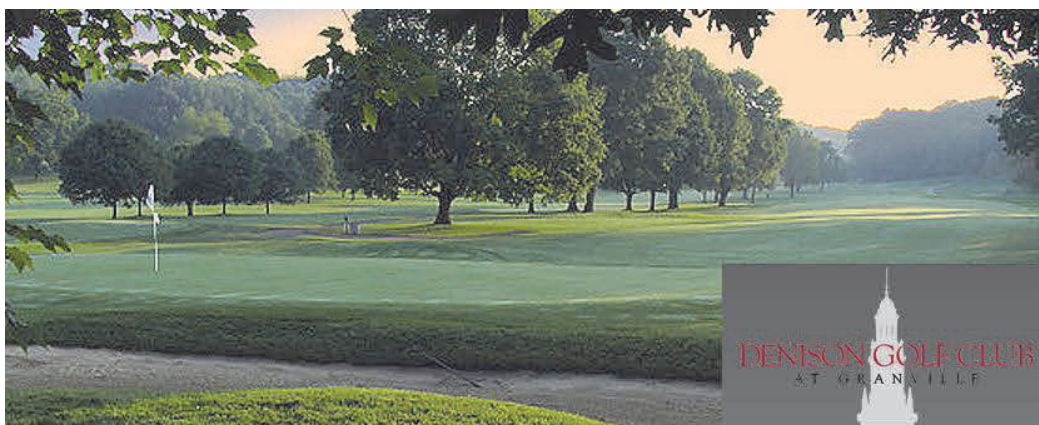

# 14<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Vincent Haven Charity Golf Outing

St. Vincent Haven (SVH) was dedicated Dec. 13, 2009 in Newark, Ohio. SVH is a privately funded 26 bed emergency program shelter for men who are homeless in Licking County. Services are geared to assist residents toward self-sufficiency and independent living on a permanent basis. Volunteer and funding support from local businesses and citizens allow SVH to provide safe shelter, support and advocacy. Assistance is provided to residents to help them find employment, improve educational skills, address mental health, health or substance abuse issues. All services at The Haven are free of charge. With the opening of the St. Vincent Haven, great strides have been made to meet the needs of men who are homeless in our community. From January 2010 through May 2021, SVH served more than 2,000 unduplicated residents, providing over 95,000 nights of safe shelter. The St. Vincent Haven Charity Golf outing has raised more than \$165,000 for the Haven. Continued funding is critical to sustain The Haven and we hope to make this year's event a huge success. ## *Know Your Saints*

**St. Thomas, Apostle** ~ St. Thomas was born a Jew and was one of the 12 Apostles. His feast day is July 3. From his one remark, he has been branded as “Doubting Thomas” ever since. But if he doubted, he also believed. He made what is certainly the most explicit statement of faith in the New Testament: “My Lord and My God!” and, in so expressing his faith, gave Christians a prayer that will be said till the end of time. He also occasioned a compliment from Jesus to all later Christians: “Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed” (John 20:29). Thomas should be equally well-known for his courage. Perhaps what he said was impetuous – since he ran, like the rest, at the showdown – but he can scarcely have been insincere when he expressed his willingness to die with Jesus. The occasion was when Jesus proposed to go to Bethany after Lazarus had died. Since Bethany was near Jerusalem, this meant walking into the very midst of his enemies and to almost certain death. Realizing this, Thomas said to the other apostles, “Let us also go to die with him” (John 11:16b). Tradition says that at the dispersal of the Apostles after Pentecost, Thomas was sent to evangelize to the Parthians, Medes, and Persians. He ultimately reached India, carrying the Faith to the Malabar coast, which still boasts a large native population calling themselves “Christians of St. Thomas.”

**St. Paulinas of Nola** ~ Born near Bordeaux, he was the son of the Roman prefect of Gaul, who had extensive property in both Gaul and Italy. Paulinus became a lawyer, holding several public offices in the Roman Empire. With his Spanish wife, Therasia, he retired at an early age to a life of cultured leisure. The two were Baptized by the bishop of Bordeaux and moved to Therasia’s estate in Spain. After many childless years, they had a son who died a week after birth. This occasioned their beginning a life of great austerity and charity, giving away most of their Spanish property. Paulinus was unexpectedly ordained a priest at Christmas by the bishop of Barcelona. He and his wife then moved to Nola, near Naples. He had a great love for Saint Felix of Nola and spent much effort in promoting devotion to this saint. Paulinus gave away most of his remaining property and continued his work for the poor. Supporting the homeless, he lived a monastic life in another part of his home. He was a correspondent and friend of Saints Augustine, Jerome, Melania, Martin, Gregory the Great, and Ambrose. He was made bishop of Nola and guided that diocese for 21 years. His feast day is June 22.

## RCIA



*“Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you to give the reason for your hope.”*

1 Peter 3:15

Are you thinking about becoming Catholic and have a lot of questions about the faith? RCIA is the process by which non-Catholics learn about the teachings of the Church and the tenets of the Catholic Faith before entering the Catholic Faith. 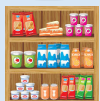

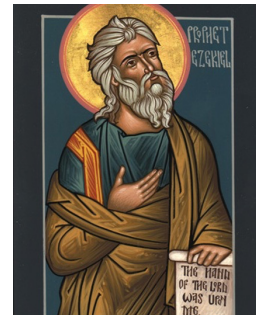
## STEWARDSHIP TIME ~ TALENT ~ TREASURE

### ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**EZ 17:22-24; PS 92:2-3, 13-14, 15-16;**

**2 COR 5:6-10; MK 4:26-34**

As we enter back into Ordinary Time, our readings today remind us that heaven is our true home and that we cannot make it there without God's assistance. In our First Reading, the prophet Ezekiel foretells the coming of the Kingdom of God. We can see that Jesus is the cedar that will become refuge for all people.
