

Dear Parishioners:

Postlude Cantors TBD ☐ For many years, St. Edward's has sung "Mine Eyes Have Seen the Glory" on a weekend near the Fourth of July. Poet Julia Ward Howe wrote the text in November 1861. Our hymnal places "Mine Eyes Have Seen the Glory" not in the "Nation & Patriotic" section, but rather in the "Second Coming" section due to its Revelation-inspired imagery describing the "coming of the Lord."

□ Today's offertory hymn is "Soul of My Savior." The text in our hymnal is an unusual hybrid. The first two verses are a translation of the traditional Catholic *Anima Christi* prayer, which has a rich history dating back about 700 years. The last verse is a composite text based on the final verse of "God of Our Fathers," which was written in 1876 to celebrate the centennial of the Declaration of Independence.

□ Now that the recent run of Sunday solemnities has ended, this weekend we switch to using the *Mass of Christ the Savior* music for the Gloria, Holy, When We Eat, Amen, and Lamb of God. We will use this Mass setting for the first portion of this long stretch of Ordinary Time.



Christmas in July for St. Vincent Haven




