Our staff feels blessed to offer you a program in a Christian faith-based setting that will prepare your child for learning in the years to come. When comparing various programs, you may want to look at: number of days offered, length of the school day, teacher/child ratio and additional supply fees.

*** Subsidy for tuition is available to St. Edward's Parish families who are "active and contributing" as defined below and on the Tuition Subsidy Request Form that may be turned in with the application:

St. Edward's Parish families may receive the parish-subsidized rate of tuition. Non-active Catholic families, Catholics from outside St. Edward Parish and families of other faiths pay the full cost per pupil. Parishioner rate is available to families who qualify for the parish subsidy.

Active member is defined by:

- Recognize the importance, and accept the responsibility of providing for your children active witness in living the Catholic faith
- ◆ Attend Holy Mass (Sat/Sunday) with your child(ren) regularly
- Be actively involved in one of our many parish activities and ministries
- ◆ Make your home a haven of family prayer, praying together regularly for your needs and those of the parish
- Regularly and faithfully support the Parish financially by using contribution envelopes or EFT (online giving) with an annual minimum contribution of \$75. If you can and do contribute more annually, your gift to the parish is greatly appreciated.

(Note: If the parish does not have record of your contributions, the subsidy cannot be applied.)

ENROLLMENT PRIORITIES: The priority levels are:

- ☐ First priority is given to children who are members of active and contributing families of the parish. Priority for the four-year old classes will be given to children previously enrolled in the 3-year-old class.
- Second priority is given to children who are members of neighboring Catholic parishes.
- ☐ Third priority is given to children of families who are non-parishioners.

TWO TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

- □ Receive 5% discount for full payment by May 15th via check, cash or through Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) checking or credit card. The full payment will be drawn on May 20th.
- □ 10 monthly installments through Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) checking or credit card to be drawn upon August 5th for the initial installment with 9 consecutive monthly payments thereafter through May 5th.

A discount is given for each additional child enrolled. There will be no tuition adjustments made for calamity days as the weather, acts of nature, and health emergencies are out of our control. We will make every effort to make up days if more than 5 days are missed due to weather or other emergencies. *Please note: The "learn from home days" are not calamity days since the preschool will be providing materials, resources, as well as virtual check-in opportunities.

REFUNDS: We expect that your child will attend the entire school year. Refunds will be at the discretion of the administration depending upon time of year and ability to find a child to fill the slot. Our budget to operate a quality program is based upon full enrollment. If a refund is granted, the refund will be subject to processing fees.
