Donations for Furnace

We are going to put a new heating system in the school building in Cherokee. Not only is the old boiler worn out, so are the pipes. Replacing the pipes and boiler would cost about \$1 million. So that is not an option. Modern Heating is going to place 4 97%-efficient hot-air furnaces in the classroom portion of the building (2 per floor) and 3 furnaces in the gym. The cost of this project is \$114,000. We are taking donations to help pay for this project. So far we have raised \$44,260. A special thanks to all who have donated. If you would like to donate to this cause, you can mail your donation in, put it in the collection basket at Mass marked as for the furnace project or give it to me whenever you see me. Remember that God is never outdone in generosity!!!
